## Summary of survey method

- Anonymous survey launched July 13
- Online only - Google forms
- Verbal reminders at Q\&A sessions
- Reminder emails on July 20 \& 28
- Results downloaded on July 30



## Response rate

Survey distribution = 136 members
Survey responses $=95$, error $\pm 5 \%$, 19 times out of 20 Response rate = 69\% !!

> Health issues make attendance risky

- Any meeting in-person can cause illness
- Require masks until no active cases in OHtawa
- All sorts of reasons to protect yourself and others by wearing a mask, noł just for covid-19
- Presenter can be unmasked but listeners should wear a mask
- Social distancing should be required
- Ensure enough space for folk to feel comfortable
- Don't live locally
- Too soon to comment

## Factors for in-person meetings



NOTE:
No big differences in factors in favour of in-person meetings between years of membership or males versus females.


- I find the travel to meetings in the evening too tiring at my age
- In-person meetings are important to the moral of the club.
- Less likely to get distracted by events unrelated to the meeting at an in-person event.
- Since I work, I had to miss topics later in the evening to get ready for sleep.
- Miss in person interaction with members.
- In person meetings were difficult for me to attend.
- Should have one or two in person meetings per year.

## STRONG FACTOR to attend virtual Zoom meeting by gender



Illness or fatigue




- Getting to and from events is difficult by bus.
- Consider MS Teams as an alternative to Zoom.
- Zoom is environmentally friendlier than using gas and it saves time.
- No driving, parking or need to dress up.
- Zoom meetings are excellent but I have to miss some when my data runs low.
- Meeting transcripts would be helpful to remember names of suggested apps, services, hardware, etc. Also it would allow for word searches and time stamps to quickly find pertinent comments.
- Much of what is discussed goes over my head. With Zoom I can choose to participate in just one or two topics
