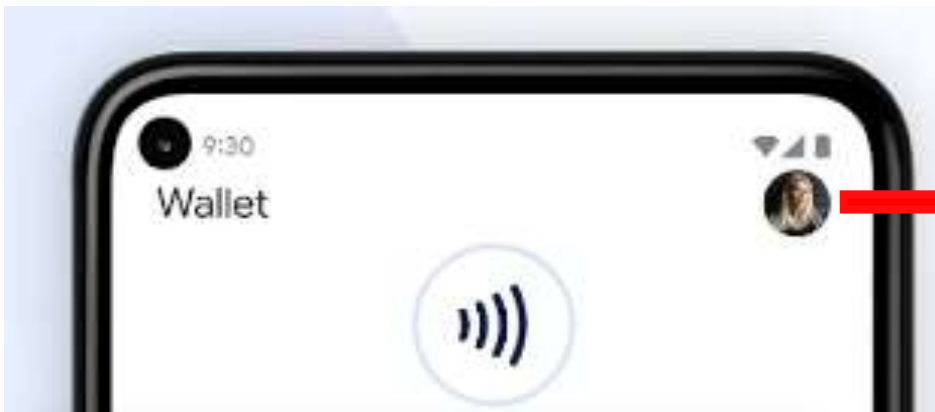
- Fast, secure access to your everyday essentials

- Installation
- Install the app from the Google Play Store
 - Click on the icon in the top-right corner and select Tips
 - Scroll down to “Participating Banks” and read the caveats!



**Select “Tips” for
how-to help**

- A lot of the wonderful features may or may not be available in Canada or your specific province
- Aside from payment cards and loyalty cards, some regions are able to add health cards, vaccination records, boarding passes and more
- Payment cards (IF they can be installed) are usually added via the camera
- After adding photos of the card, and details like expiry date, your card's issuer will be contacted to validate use of the card with the software wallet
- There will be a text message, E-mail, or a phone call to verify all things are legitimate
- You'll then be good to go.

Wash, rinse, repeat
