# What is Directory Opus?

- **Directory Opus is a complete replacement for Explorer (Win + E) , with far more power and functionality than any other file manager available today.**
- Single or dual pane file display and folder trees
- Fully configurable user interface—colors, fonts, toolbars, keyboard hotkeys, and a full scripting interface let you tailor Opus exactly to suit your needs
- Tabbed interface let you keep multiple folders open and switch quickly between them
- Quickly filter, sort, group and search your folders
- Color-code your files, assign status icons, star ratings, tags and descriptions
- View images, documents, media files, and more
- View and edit file metadata
- Image marking lets you sort your photos quickly and easily
- Batch renaming, including easy-to-use keyboard macros
- Synchronization and duplicate file finder built-in tools
- Print or export folder listings
- Support for FTP and archive formats like Zip, 7Zip and RAR

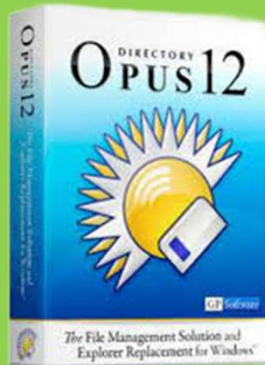

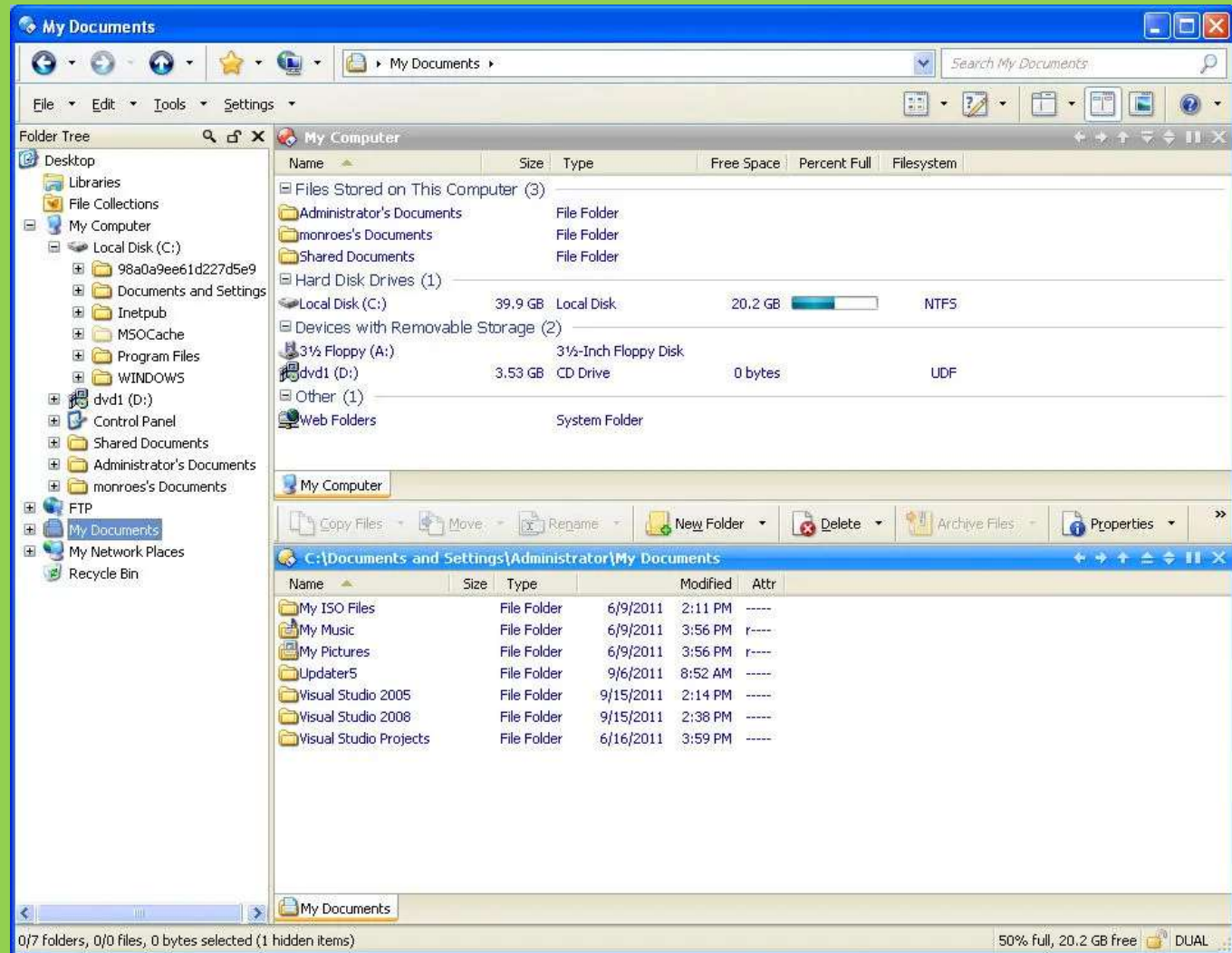

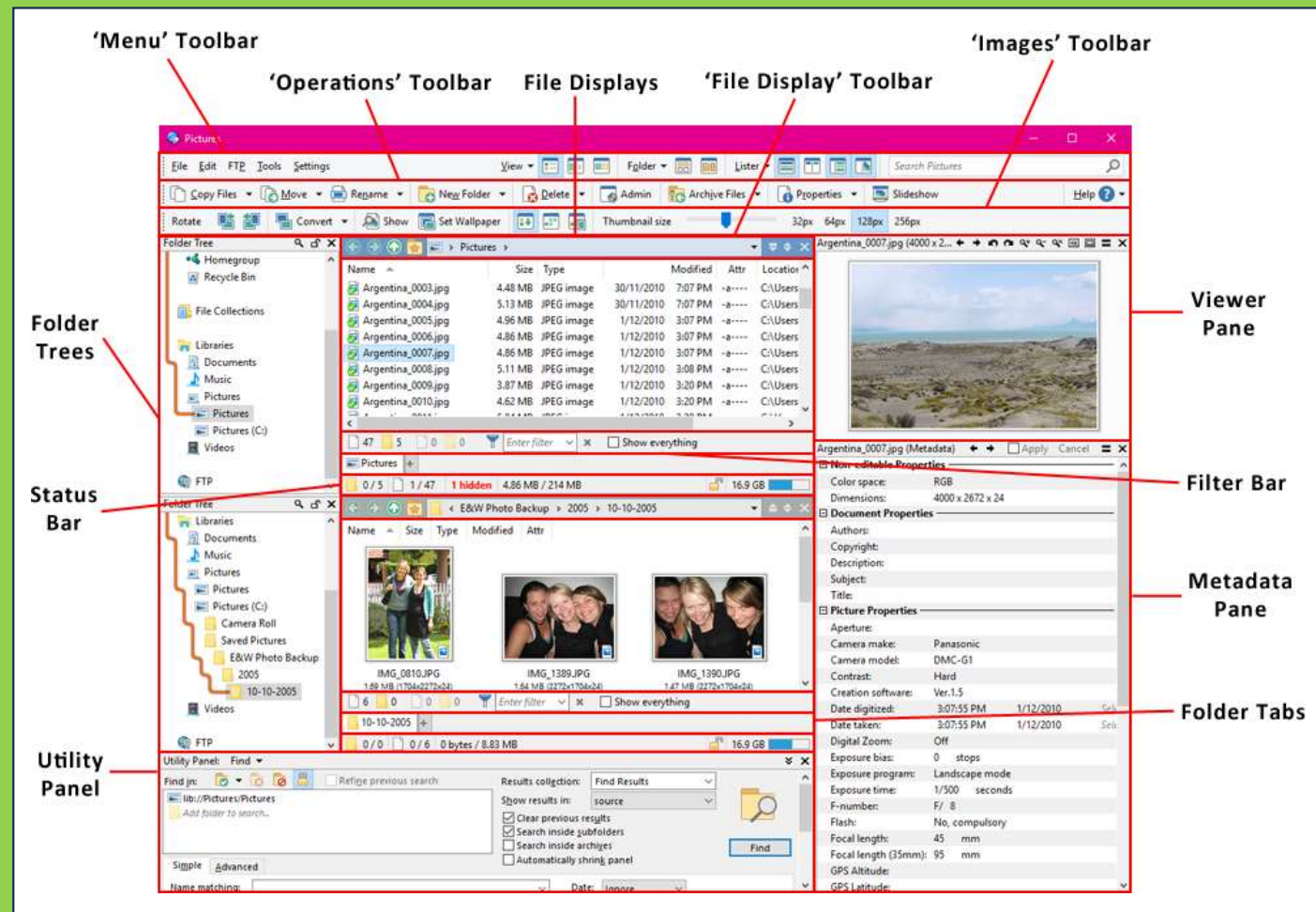

At first look, Directory Opus could easily be mistaken for “just another file manager”.



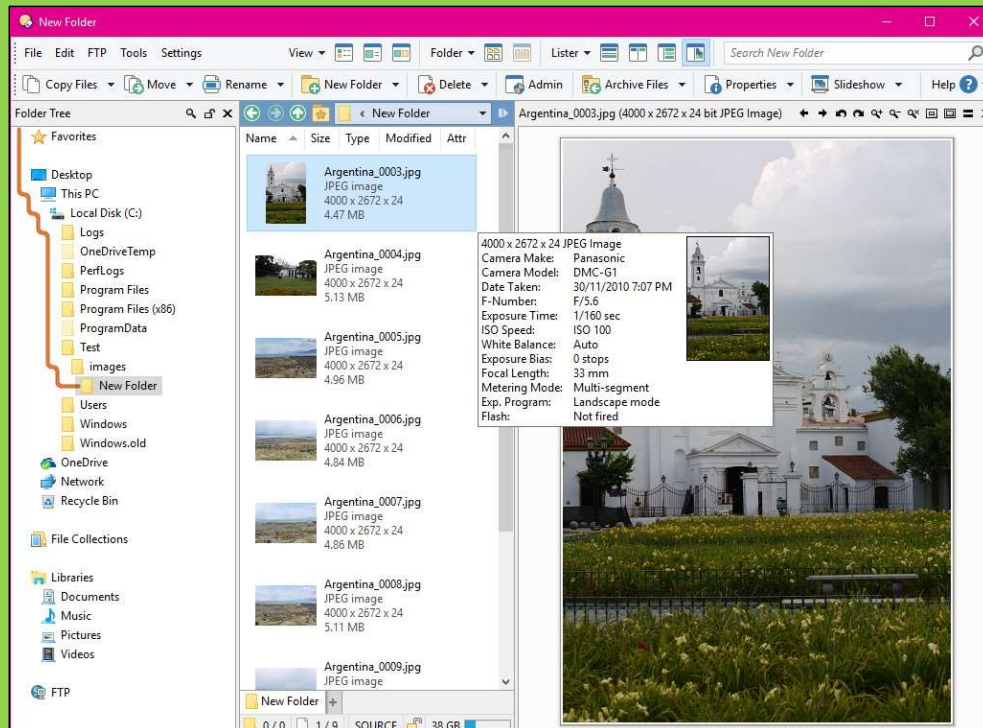

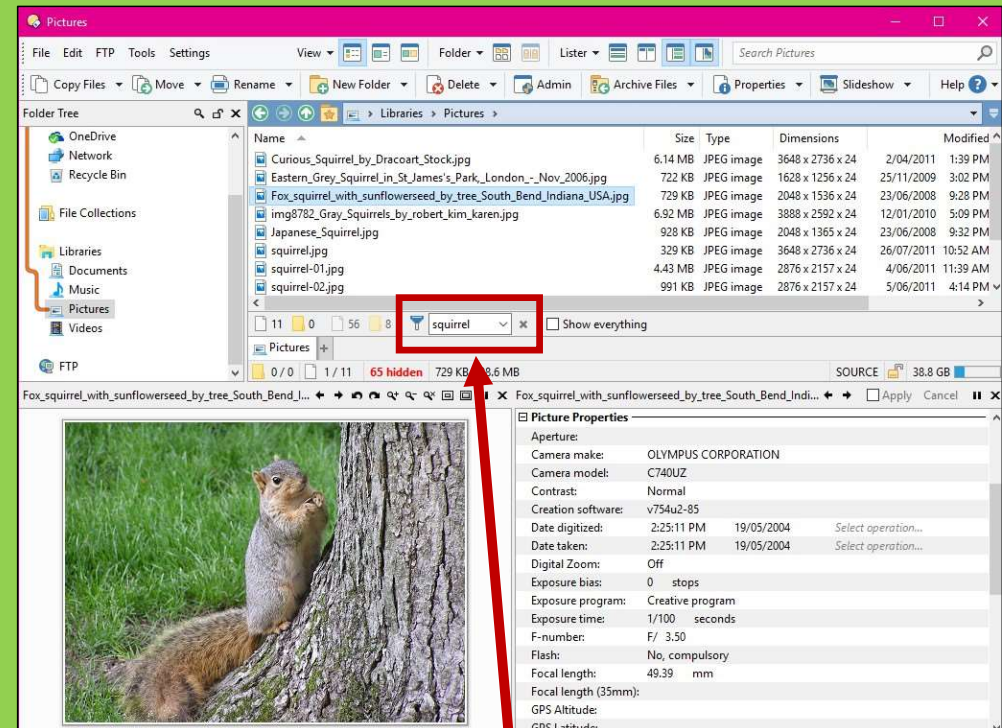

Tiles mode, with viewer pane displayed.

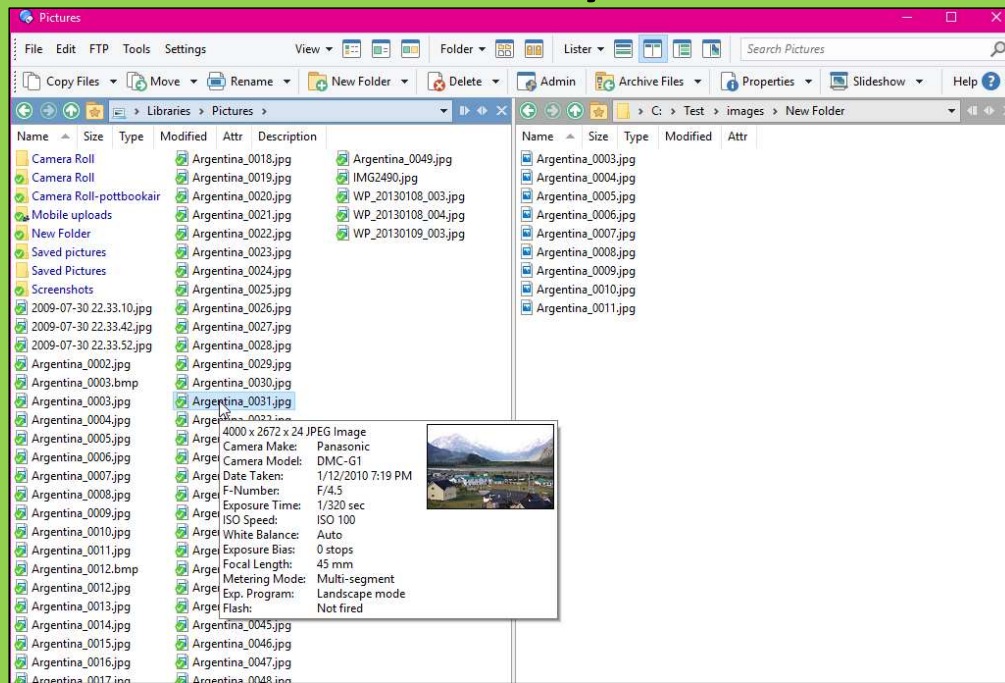
Single display in details mode



The file list has been filtered to show only files matching the specified keyword. At the bottom, the viewer pane and the metadata pane are both displayed.

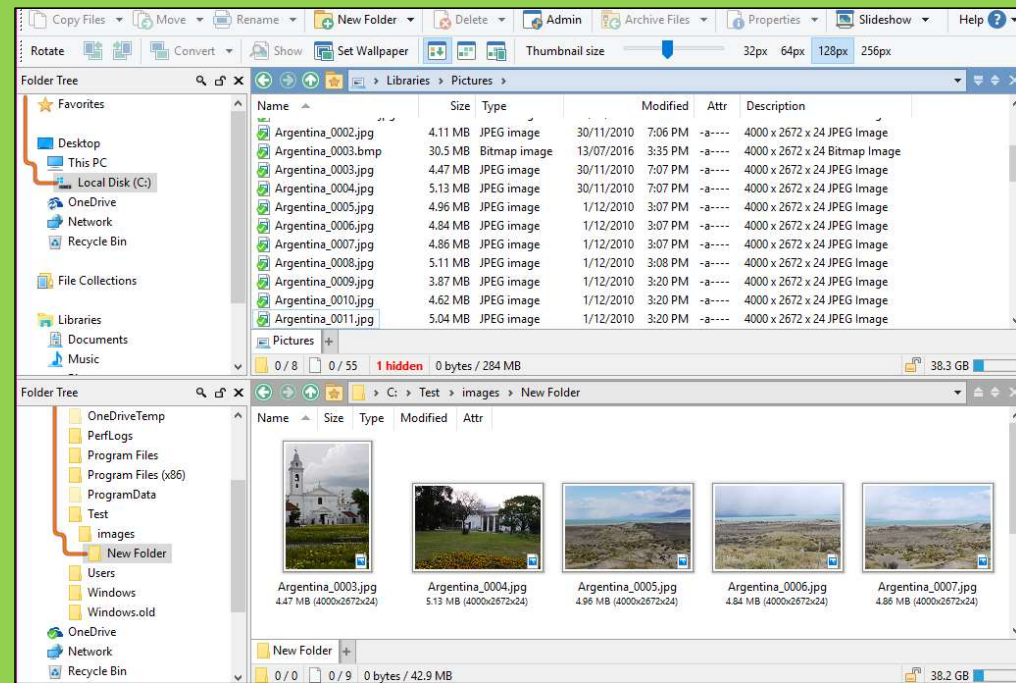

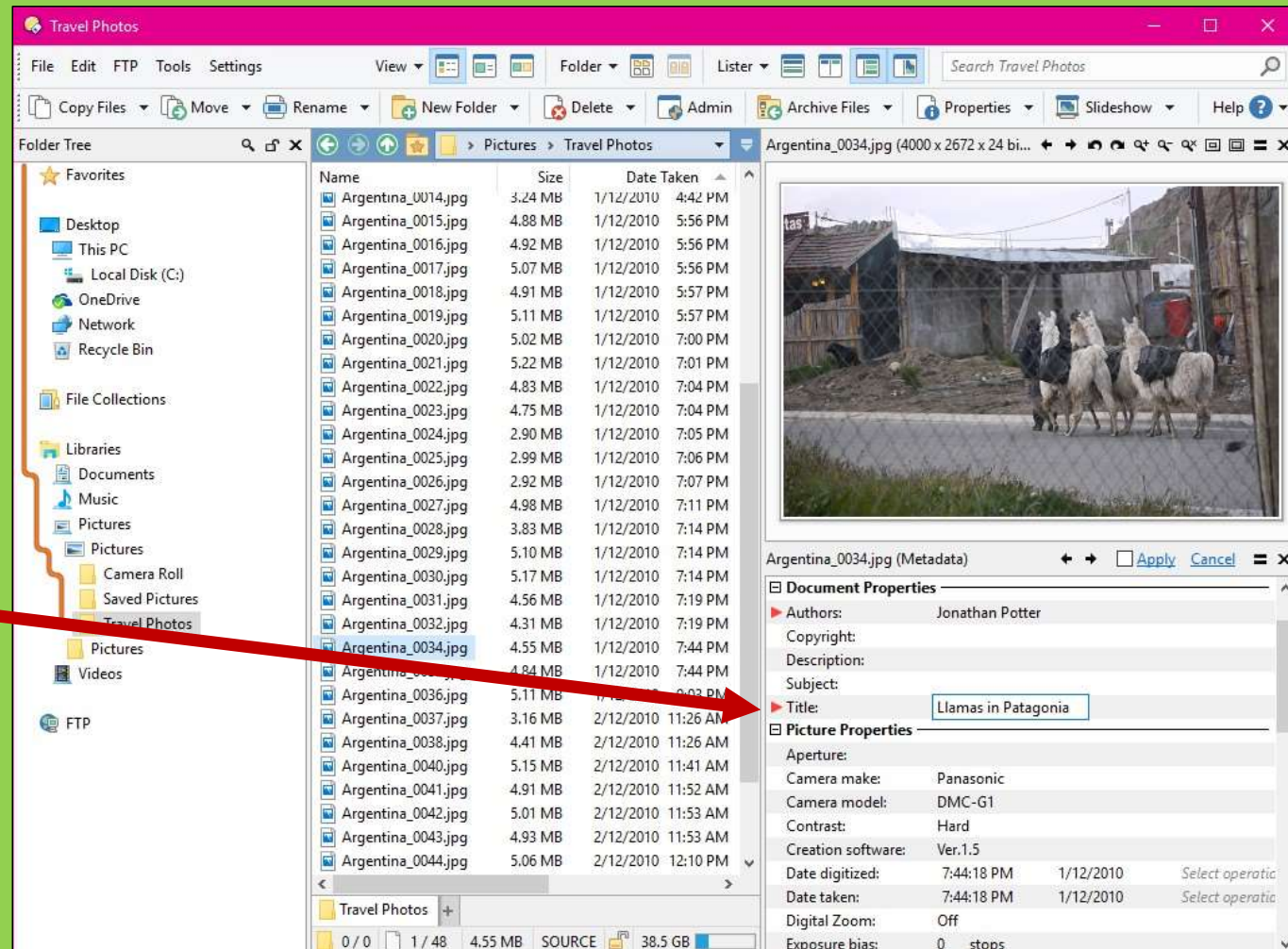

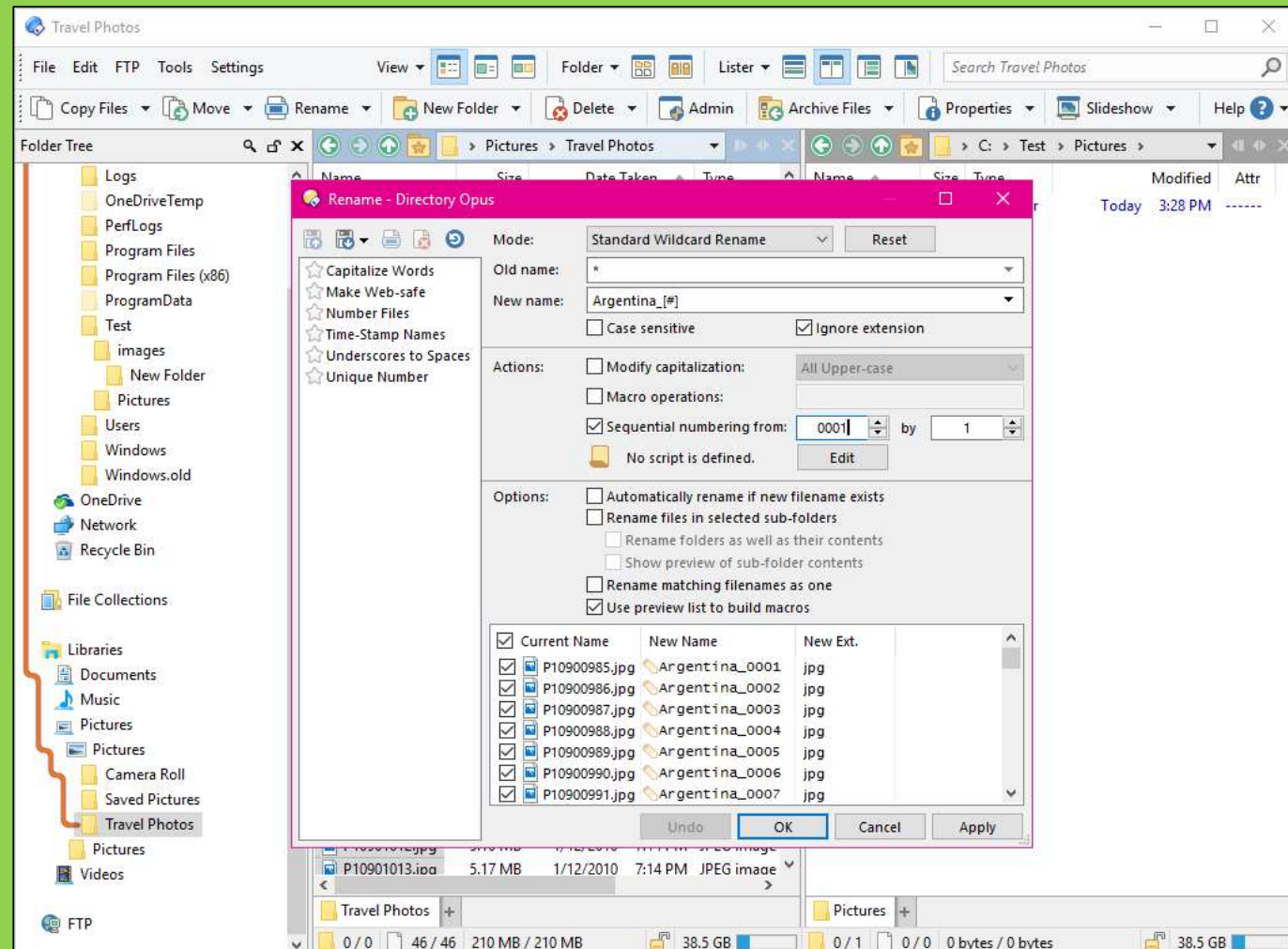

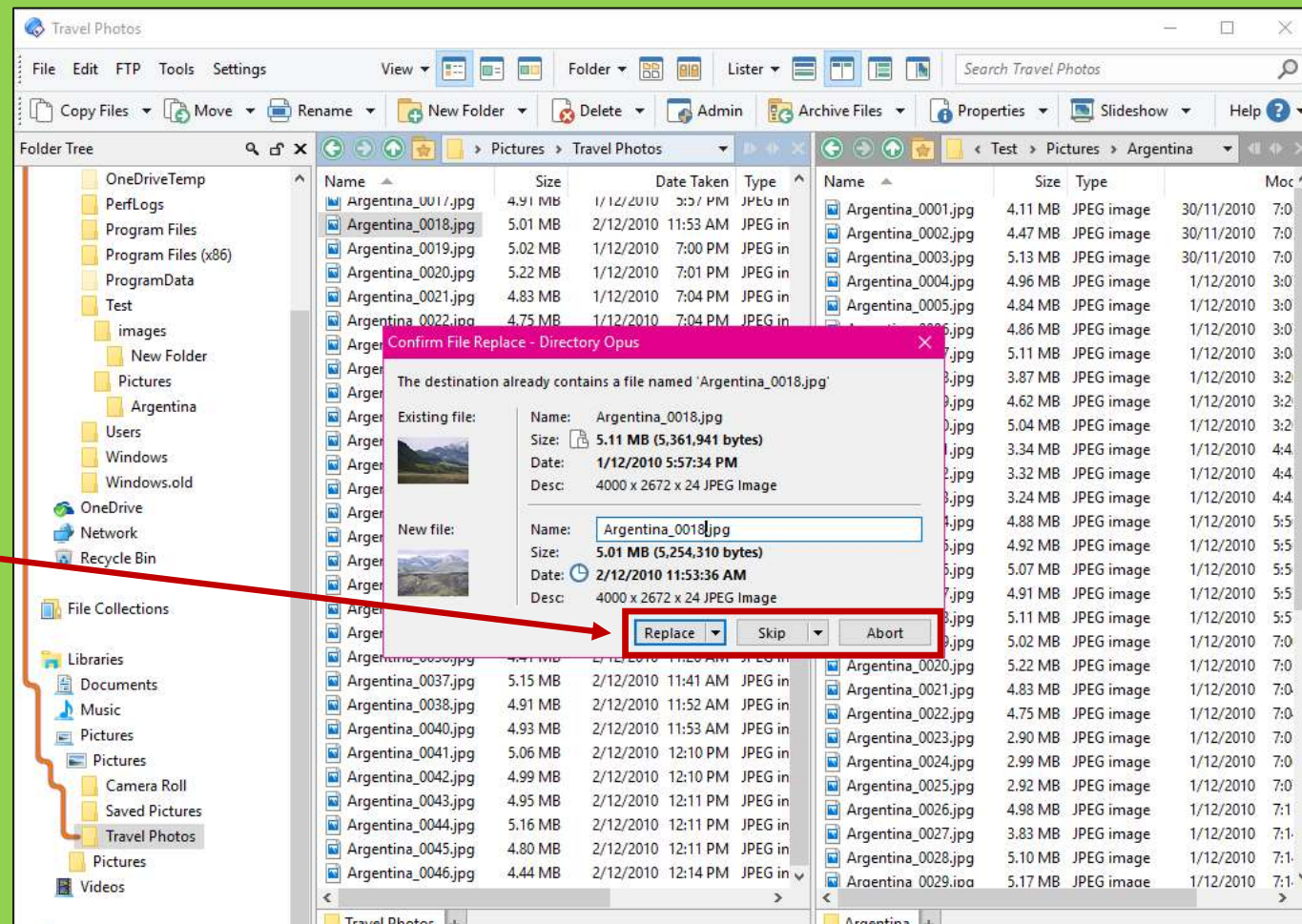

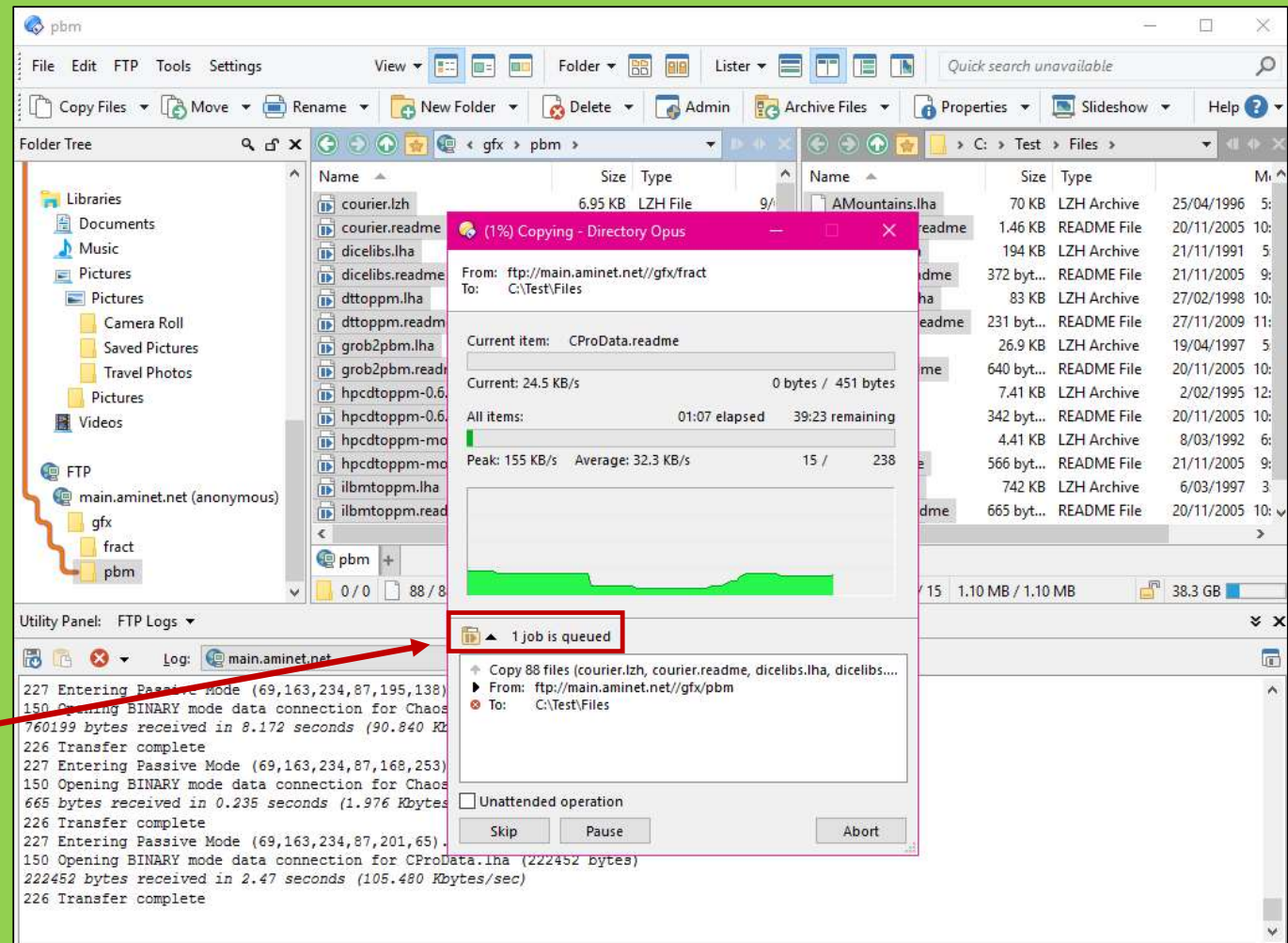

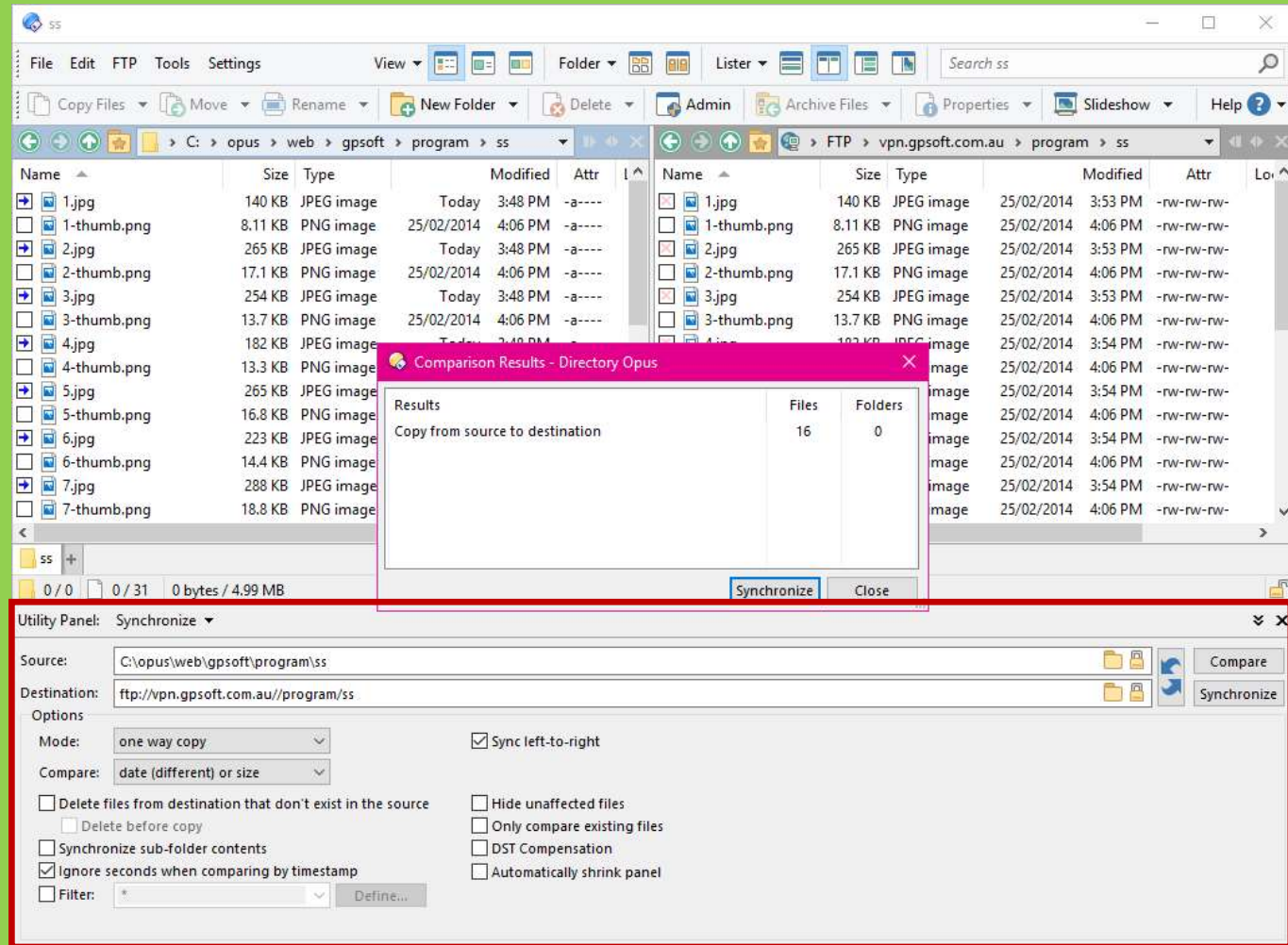
A copy job is queued to begin once the current copy completes.

The synchronize tool supports both one-way and two-way synchronization.

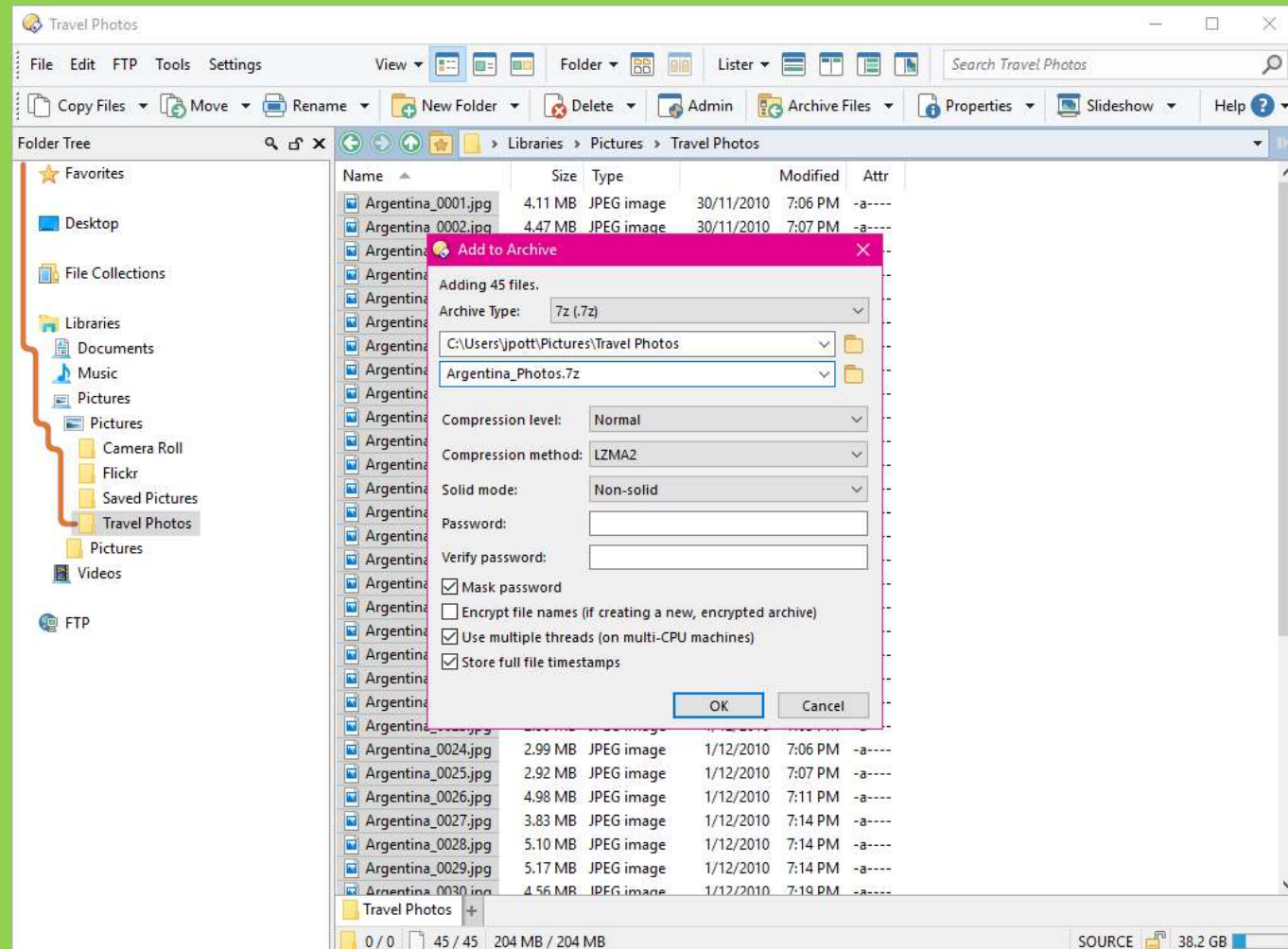
In this image the synchronization is between a local folder and a remote FTP site

Here the search is for images modified within the past two years that are at least 1280x1024 pixels in size.



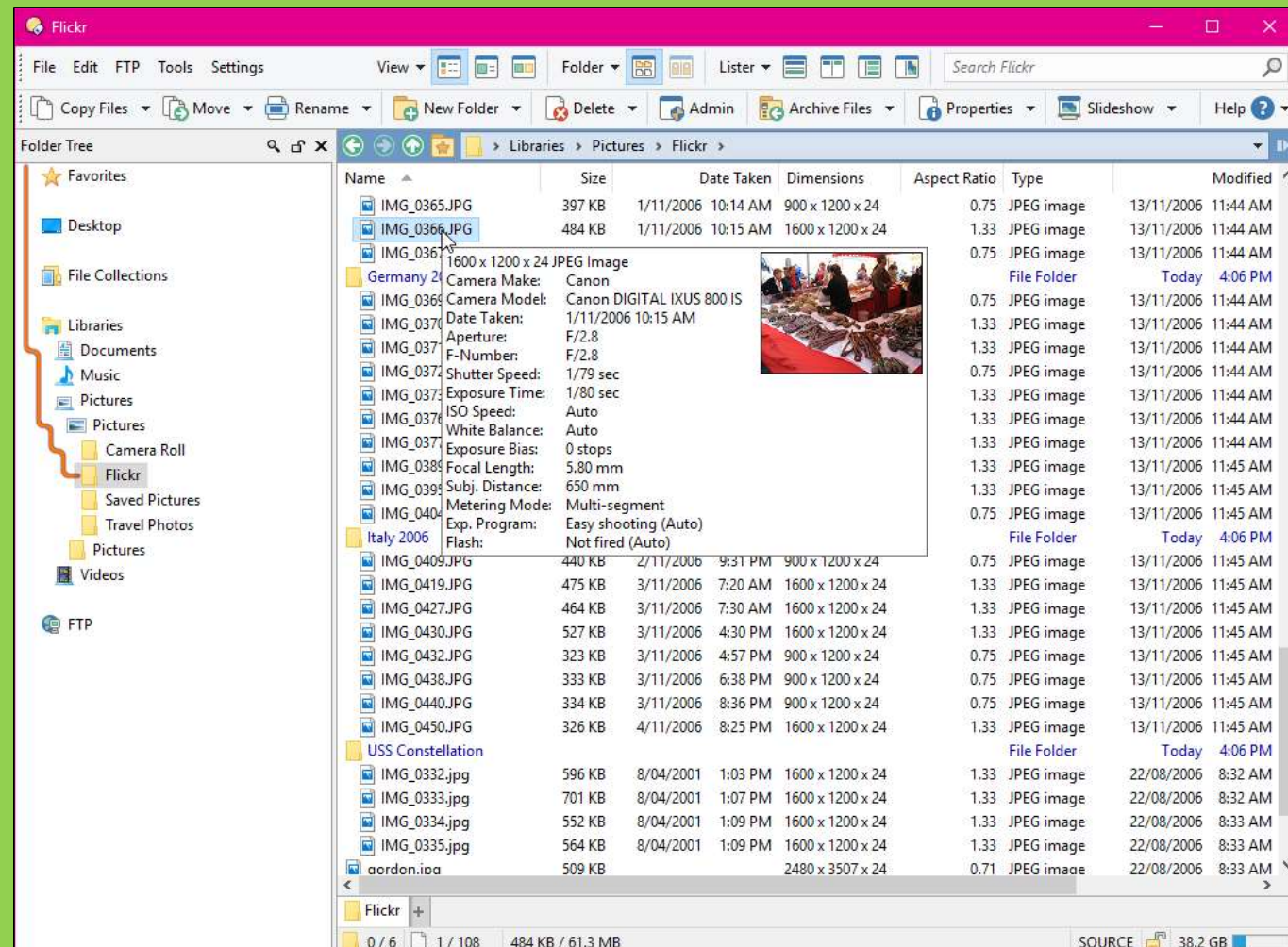


# Flat View™

Flat View™ lets you display the contents of all sub-folders at once.

This is particularly useful for organizing files with a complicated folder structure

Also displayed are some of the many picture information columns you can add to the file display.



# Why I chose Directory Opus over all other Windows/File Explorers



- As you know from my presentation **How to get paid software for free daily ... totally legally!**, I test a lot of software, and I was looking for a way to sort them and get better and quicker access to them.
- At the same time, I was looking for a way to replace the **Windows Start** menu, which was too limited for my needs.
- Looking at Directory Opus, I discovered that you can create quick-link buttons not only to your favourite **directories** and **files**, including **media files**, but also to **websites**, and most importantly for me, to **installed programs** on your computer, which is exactly what I was looking for!
- I also discovered the **file name color coding** feature ...
- ... the **toolbars**, especially the **Tabbar** ...
- ... the **customization** possibilities...
- ... and the **Flat View™** functionalities ...

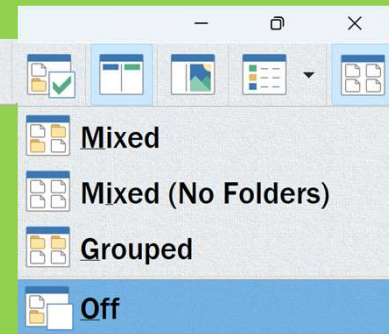


Styles: Commander Dual Vertical Explorer Filmstrip Images Single Metadata Dual Horizontal

**Flat View** is a mode you can turn on in a Lister that enables you to **view all the contents of a folder's sub-folders at once**. In effect it **collapses, or flattens, the display of a nested hierarchy of folders and files into a single folder**.

The three different types of Flat View™ mode are:

1. **Mixed:** Displays the contents of the current folder and all its sub-folders (and all their sub-folders, and so on recursively) as if they were all in the one location.
2. **Mixed (No Folders):** Displays all the files in the current folder and all sub-folders as if they were all in the one location. Sub-folders themselves are hidden from the display.
3. **Grouped:** Displays the contents of all sub-folders as a tree hierarchy.

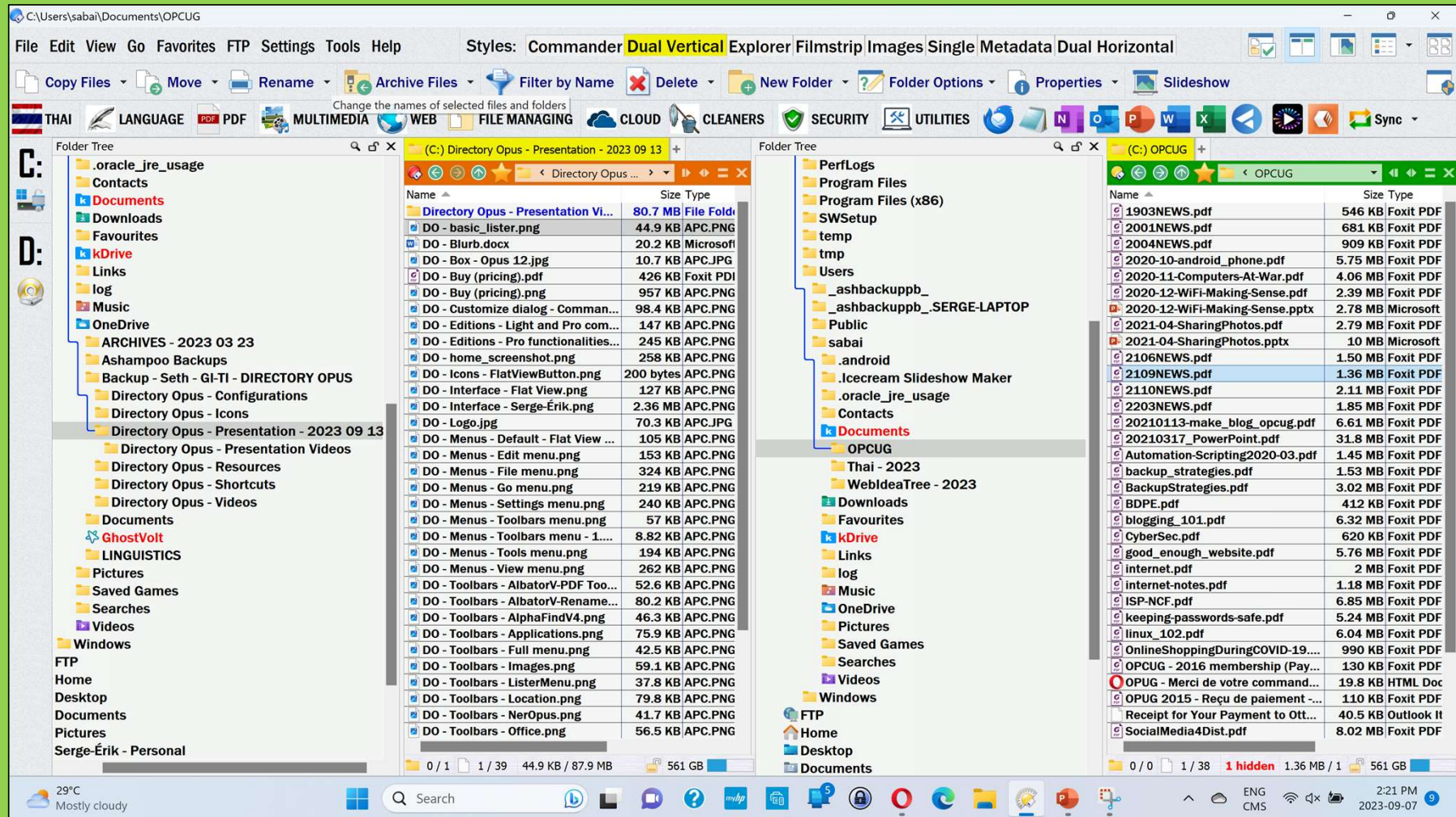

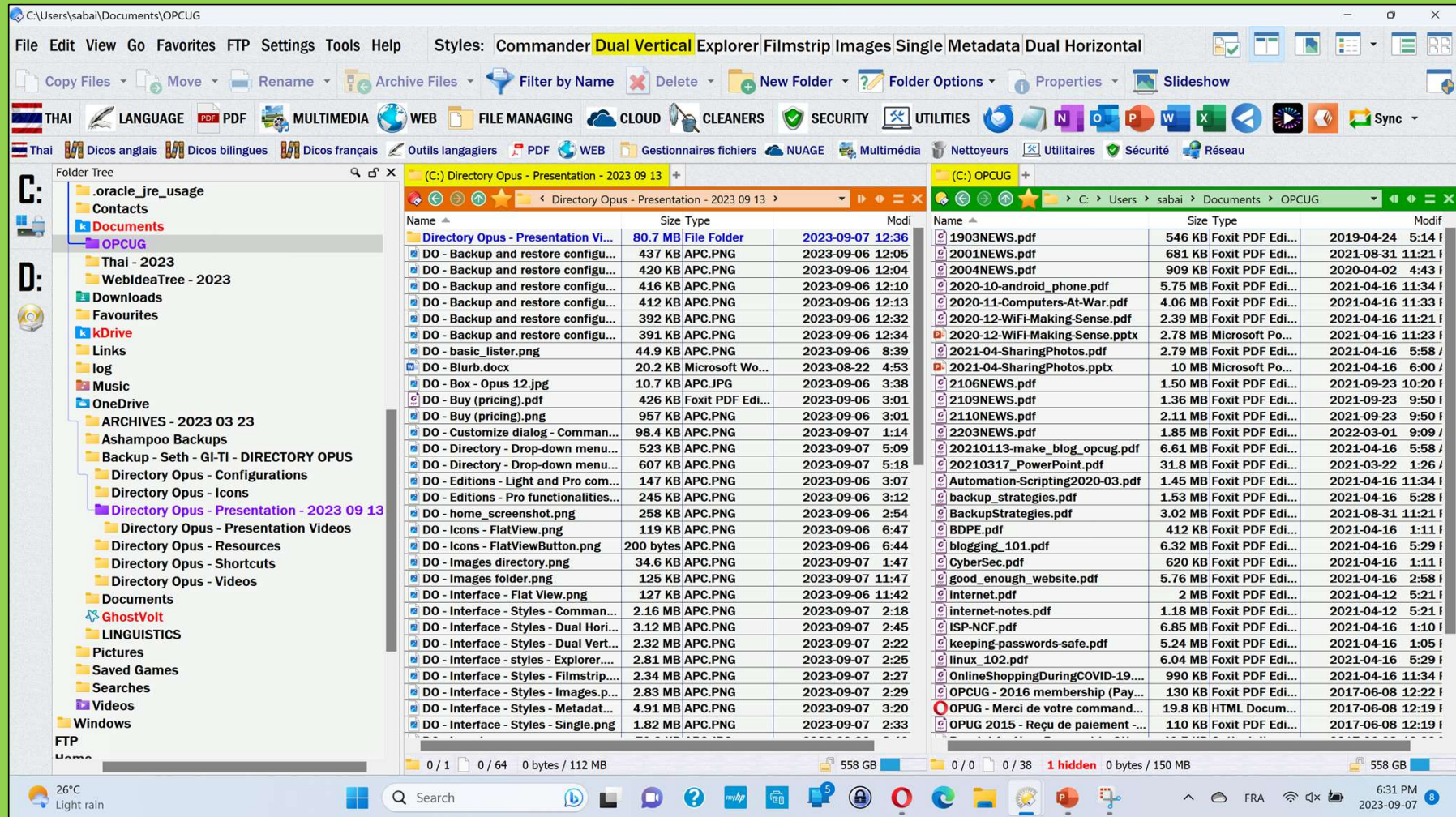

Setting Up a New Computer – Keeping Up To Date

**Update applications**  
The story so far – we have brought the Windows operating system up to date with security patches in the need to maintain all of the installed applications by updating these as new versions and app-specific security patches become available. Many programs will relieve you of this burden by silently installing updates. For example, Google Chrome will install updated versions automatically, but will notify you to restart the browser in order to complete the installation process. Other packages, such as FreeFileSync and KeePass, will display a message alerting you to the availability of a new version of the software.

**System Backup**  
Considerable time and effort has been expended to create a working computer. It is important to be able to recover this state in the event of problems, and to do so with minimal further effort. You don't want to have to repeat all the steps in the first two parts of this series! The problems to guard against are two-fold, namely disaster recovery and corrupted or accidentally deleted files. Both of these issues can be readily mitigated through the use of backup systems.

**Windows Update**  
The operating system and any Microsoft applications (e.g. Office) are automatically kept up to date by Windows Update. The update process normally occurs on the second Tuesday of each month (Patch Tuesday). Any emergency patches are applied as necessary, at any time, as "out-of-band" updates.

**Another useful option is to occasionally run Software Update Monitor (SUMo) from KC Software.** When this application is run, it will first indicate if there is any update available for SUMo itself. The program then scans your computer for installed software and detects any packages requiring updating. Updates in the list are categorized as Major (red), Minor (orange), and OK (green). Both the current version and the version number of any update are noted. A Get Update icon allows an application to be updated through KC Software's web site, or an updated version can be obtained manually from the developer's site. SUMo doesn't differentiate between updates for security and non-security purposes, but is very useful for identifying software that can be updated at the user's option.

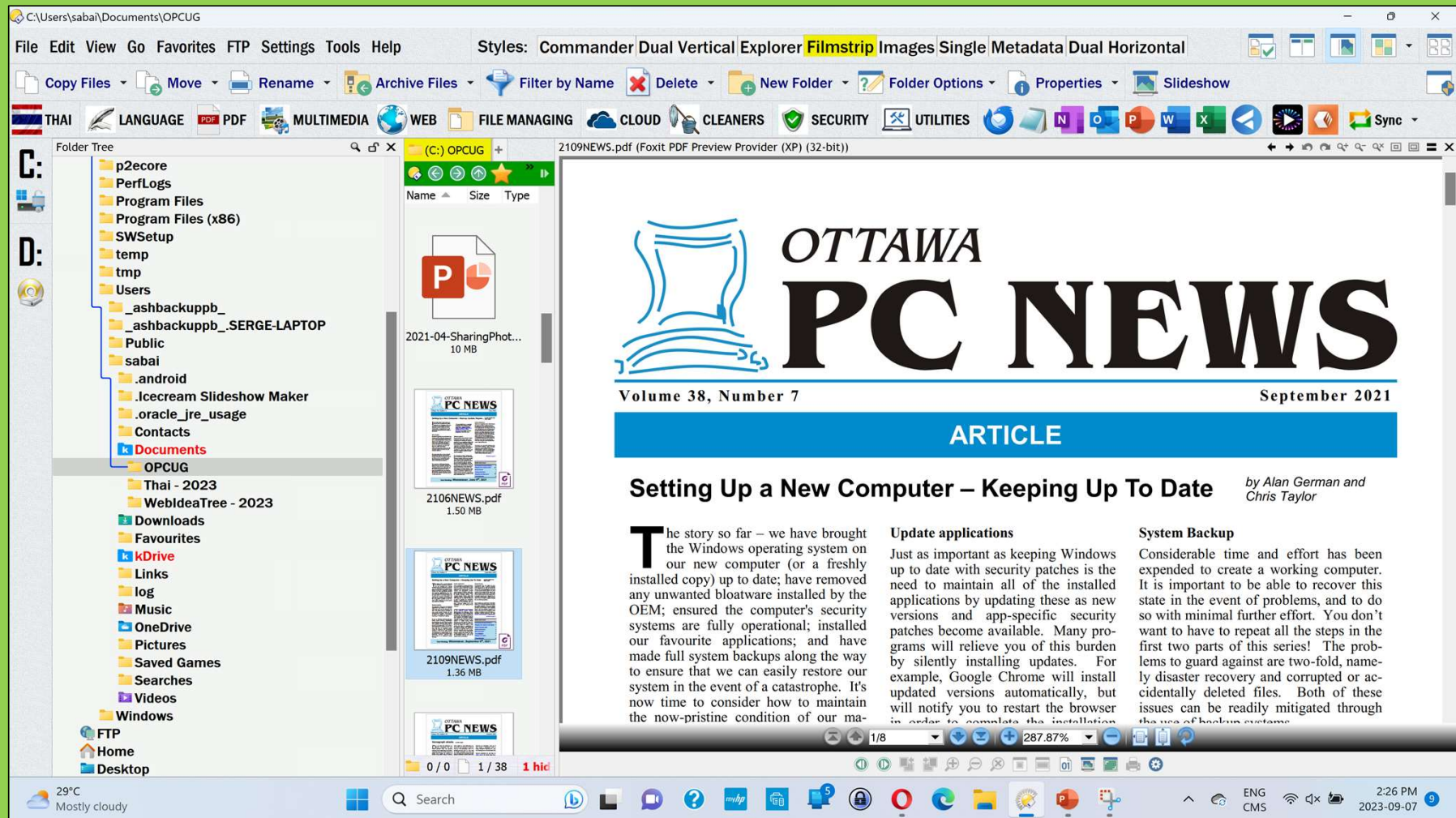
**For example, you could have a hard drive failure or an electrical problem that fries your entire computer. Once you replace the failed hardware, you want to quickly get back up and running with everything intact. The most effective solution is an image backup of your computer, which includes everything on the hard drives — operating system, programs, and data. EaseUS Todo Backup is a good, feature-**

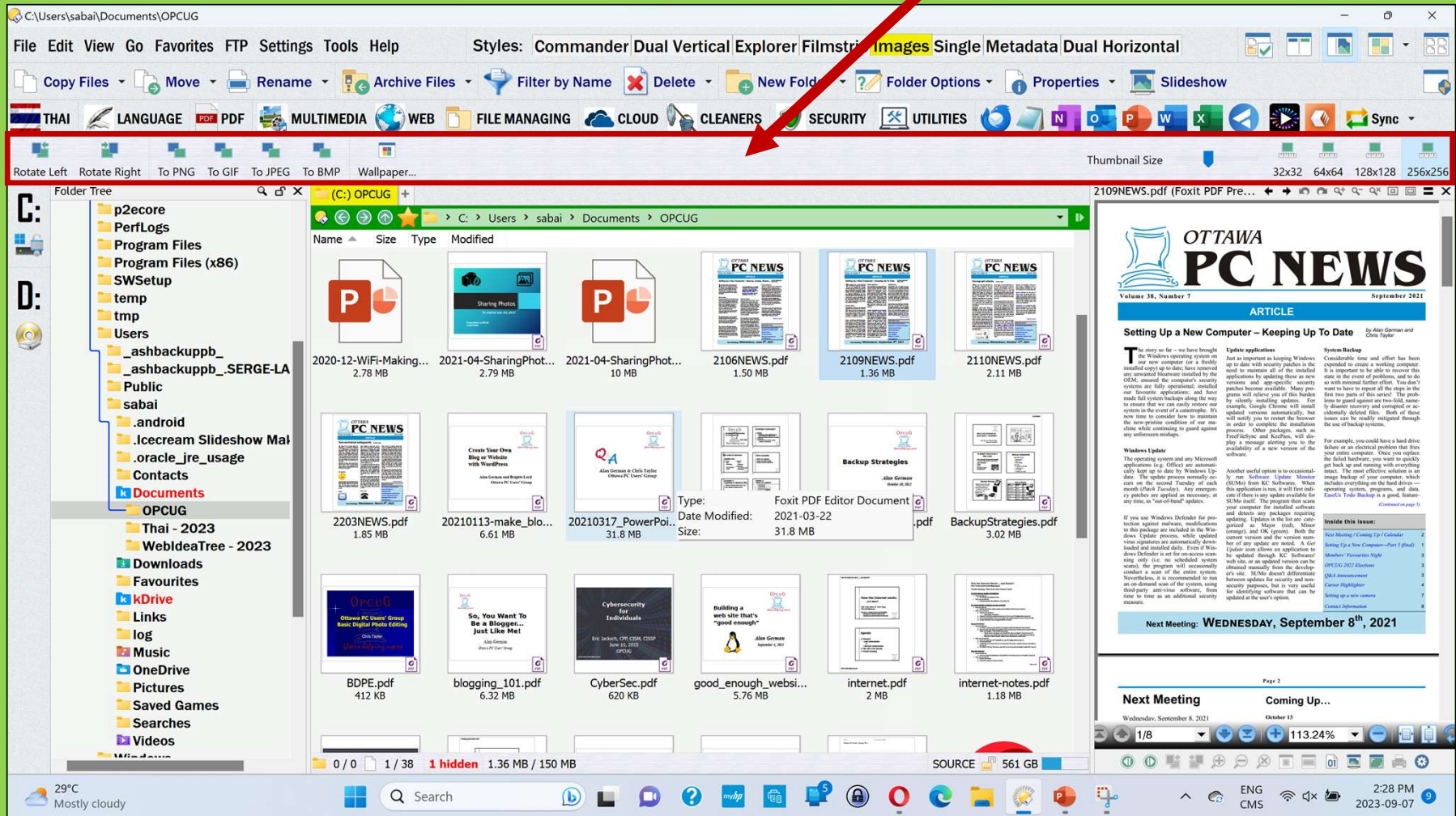

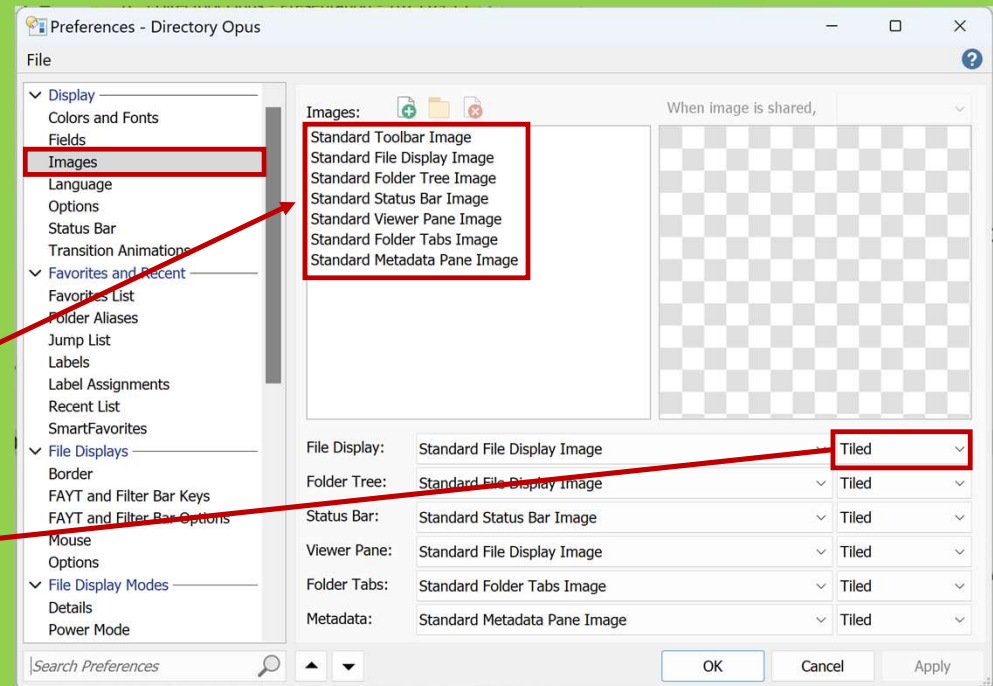
# How to change the background of the toolbars

Toolbar backgrounds can be changed to any solid color or to an image (e.g., a Windows textured wallpaper). To do so:

1. Go to **Settings > Preferences**
2. Under **Display**, click on **Image**
3. Select the object to modify
4. For each one, select the **display mode**:



Remember that you must first set your customized backgrounds in the **Preferences** dialog in order to be able to customize the toolbar backgrounds from the **Customize** dialog.

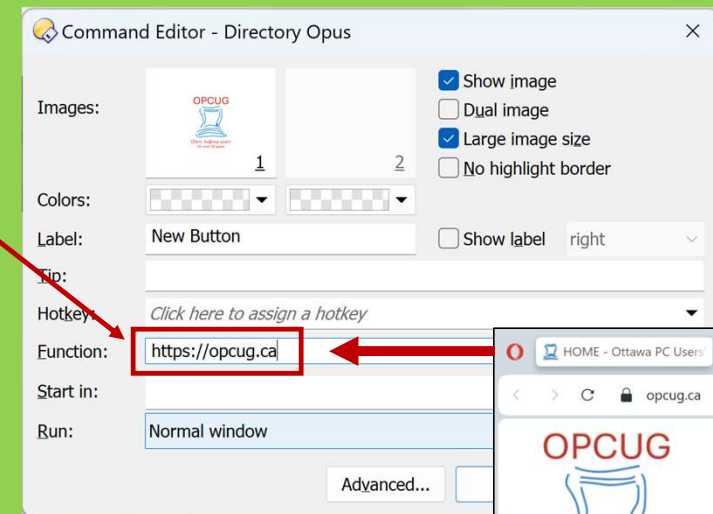
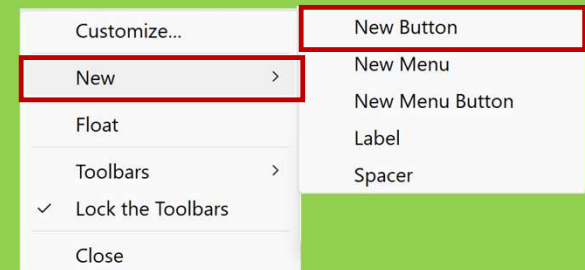

## Method 1

1. Go to **Settings > Customize...**
2. Right click on the toolbar of your choice.
3. Click on New and choose **New Button**.
4. Right click on the button and choose **Edit**.
5. In the **Function field** of the **Command Editor**, paste the **path of the file/directory** or the **address of the website (URL)** you want quick or regular access to.



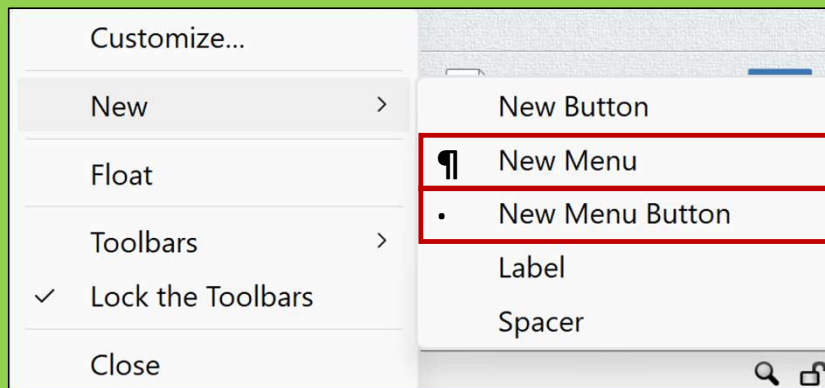

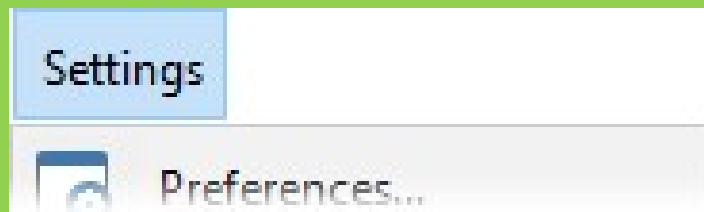

# Drop-down Menus

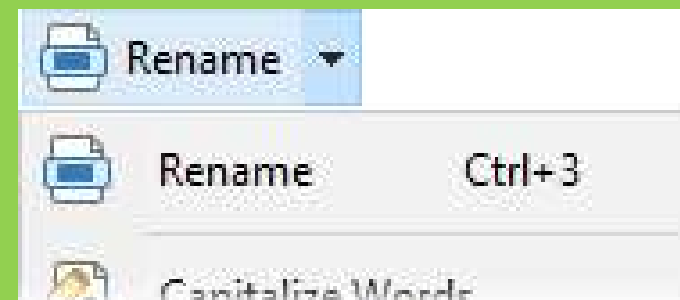


¶ A drop-down **Menu** is a button that displays a menu, and nothing more. Clicking the button makes the menu appear.



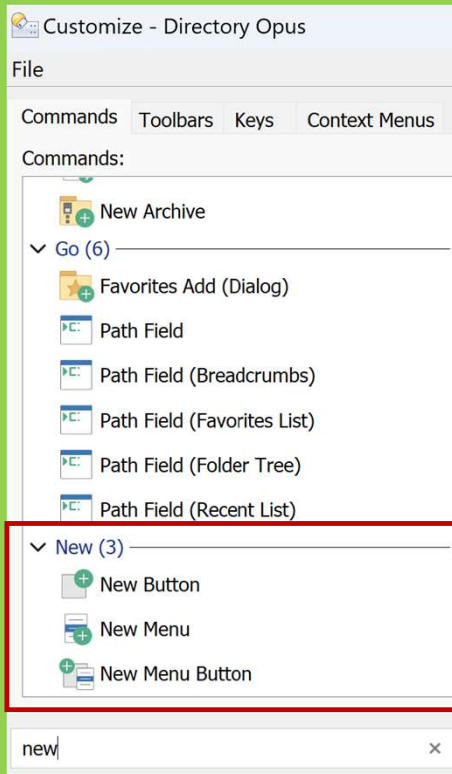
• A drop-down **Menu Button** is like a regular button combined with a menu. It has two distinct parts:

1. The larger part—the label—acts like a regular button. It can have a function defined for it, and clicking the button part runs the function.
2. The smaller part—the arrow glyph—displays the drop-down menu. Clicking the arrow part of the button drops the menu down.

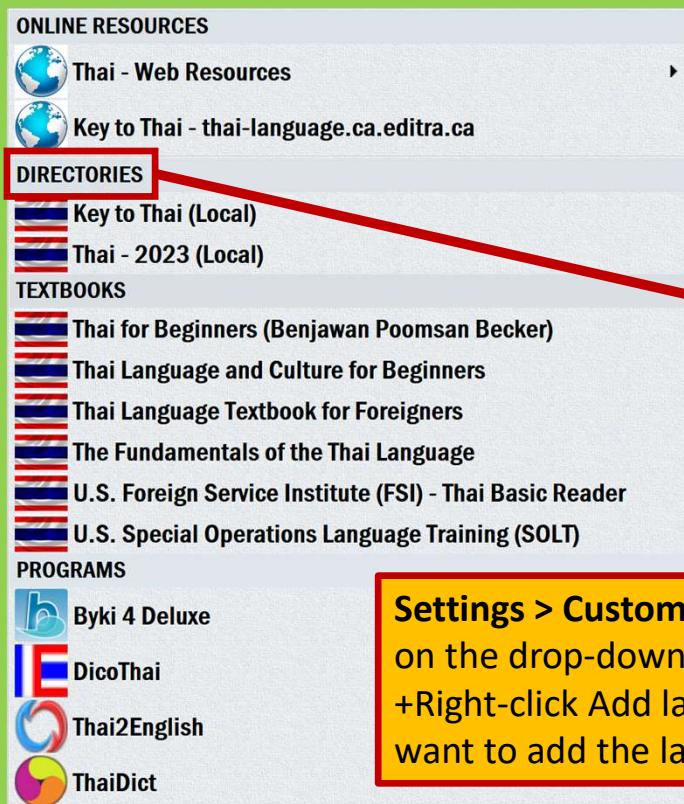


To add a brand new sub-menu (within which you can then add further items) to a toolbar, do any of the following:

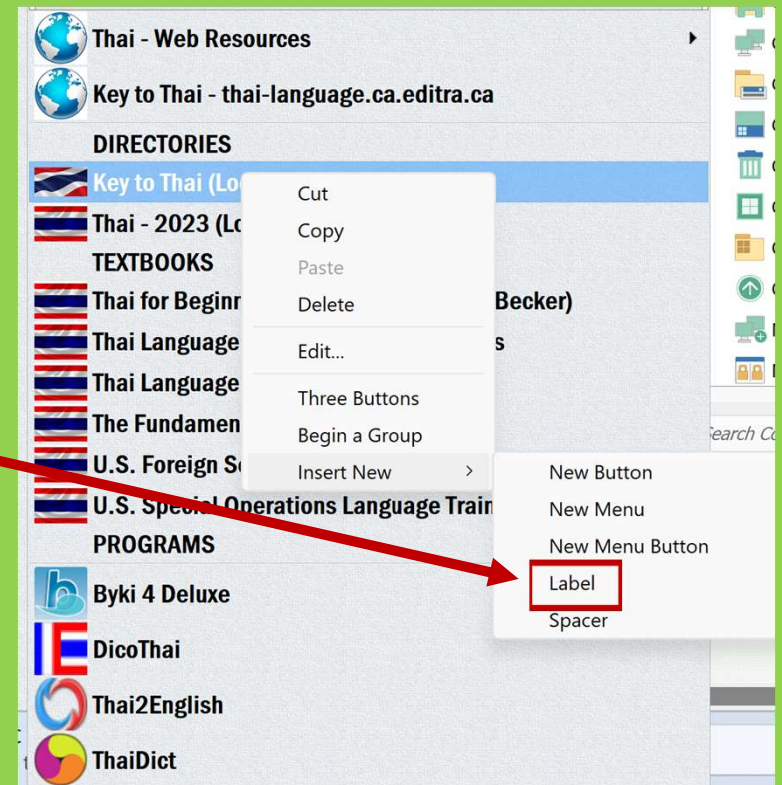
1. From the **Customize** dialog's **Commands** tab, expand the **New** category, then drag **New Menu** (or **New Menu Button**) out of the list and drop it on the toolbar. This will add the menu at the location you dropped it.
2. Right-click the empty space at the end of a toolbar and choose **New > New Menu** (or **New Menu Button**) from the context menu. This will add the button to the end of the toolbar.
3. Right-click an existing button or menu and choose Insert **New > New Button** (or **New Menu Button**) to insert the new menu immediately after the one you clicked on.

Once the new menu is added, you can edit it (by double-click or right-click), and if you open it with a left-click you can add items inside of it in the same way as the top-level toolbar.

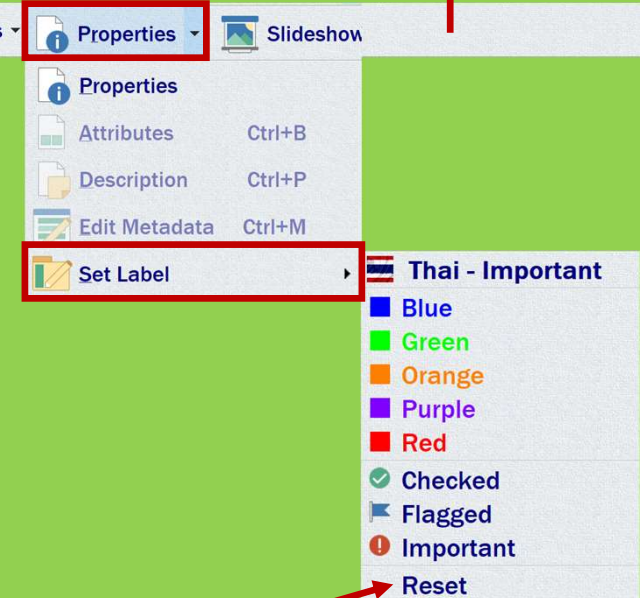

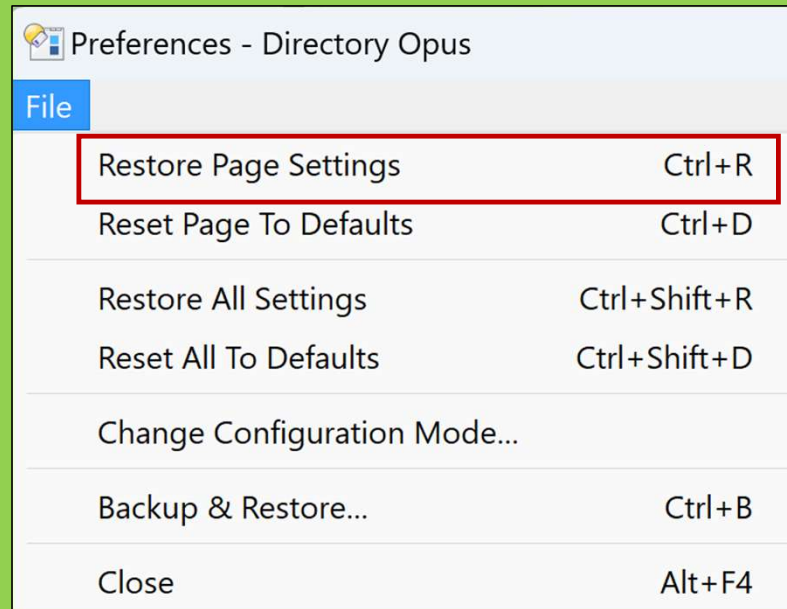
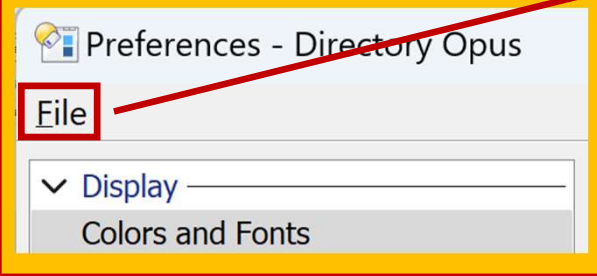

# The File Preferences Menu: Testing Your Settings

At the very top of the Preferences dialog is the **File** menu; this contains a number of useful commands:

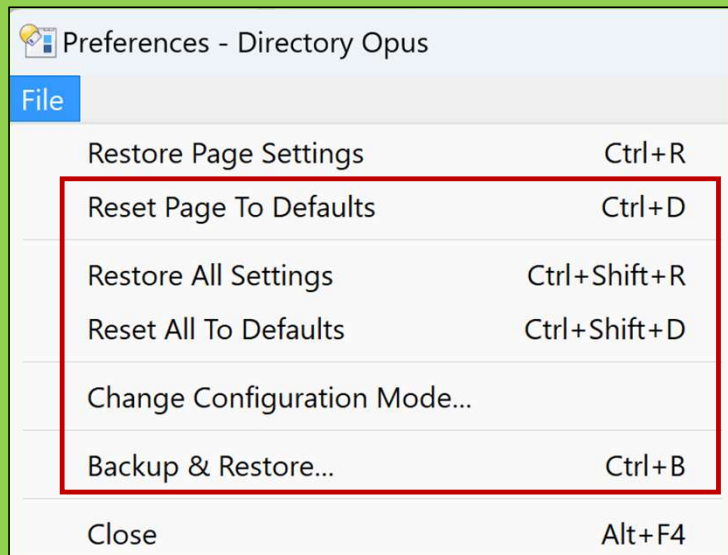


**IMPORTANT**

## Restore Page Settings:

- Restores all the settings on the current page to their values when Preferences was first opened.
- This even works if you have clicked the Apply button to apply your changes—you can undo any changes at any time as long as you don't close the Preferences dialog.

# The File Preferences Menu: The Other Options



- **Reset Page To Defaults:** Resets all the settings **on the current page** to their default values.
- **Restore All Settings:** Restores all the settings **on all pages** to their original values (from when Preferences was first opened).
- **Reset All To Defaults:** Resets all the settings on all pages to their default values.
- **Change Configuration Mode:** Lets you change between the two different configuration modes that Opus supports.
  - **Private configuration:** Each user of the computer will have their own Opus configuration, completely separate from every other user's.
  - **Shared configuration:** There is only one global Opus configuration, and all computer users share it (so changes one user makes to the configuration affects all other users).
- **Backup & Restore:** Access the Preferences backup and restore system.

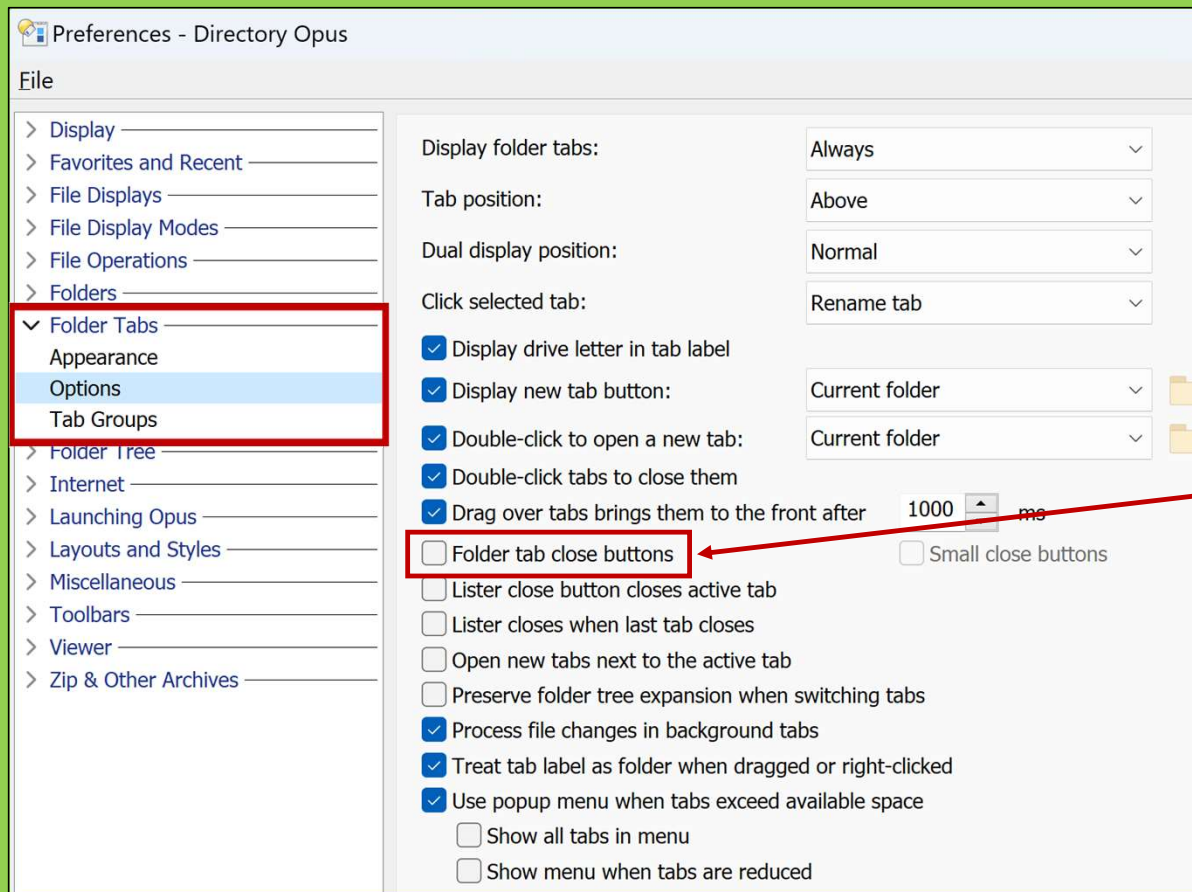

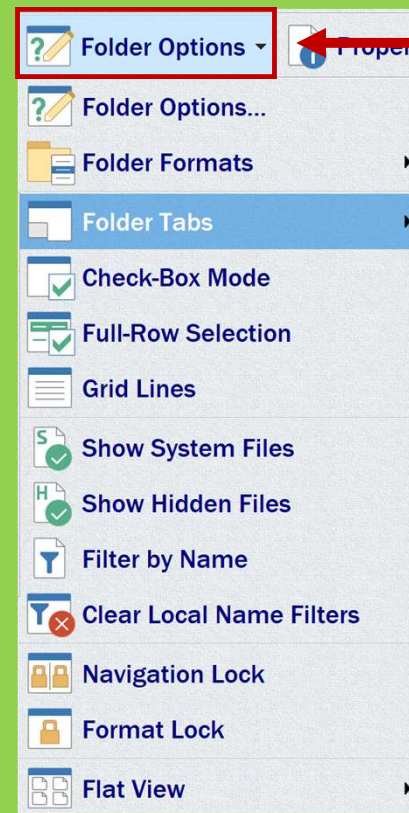

# Folder Tab Controls from the Folder Options Button

The **Folder Options / Folder Tabs** menu (  ) in the default toolbars contains a number of commands used to control tabs:

- **New Tab for Current:** Opens the current folder in a new tab.
- **New Tab for Parent:** Opens the parent of the current folder in a new tab.
- **New Tabs for Selected:** Opens any selected folders in new tabs (for example, selecting three sub-folders in the current folder and run this command, would result in three new tabs being opened showing those folders).
- **New Tabs for Parents:** Opens the parents of any selected items in new tabs. This is useful in a collection (e.g. Find Results) where the parent of the selected items is not necessarily the current folder.
- **Tab Groups:** This sub-menu lets you access any tag groups you have defined.
- **Close Tab:** Closes the current folder tab.
- **Undo Close Tab:** Re-opens the most recently closed folder tab.

# File Collections

- A **file collection** is a virtual folder that acts as a container for other files and folders.
- The items in a file collection do not need to be stored in the same physical folder—they can reside in other folders, on other disks, or even in other virtual file systems like FTP.
- When you add items to a collection they are not actually moved or modified at all—all Opus stores is a reference to the original file.
- Collections are also used by the **flickr** photo-sharing synchronization system to store references to your photos no matter where on your system they are physically located.

You can work with the files in a file collection (copy them, rename them, delete them, etc.) just like you would with the real files.





# Image Marking

- A common task is sorting through a bunch of digital photos, working out which ones to keep, which ones to upload, which ones to print, etc. The Image Marking feature in the standalone viewer can make this process very simple.
- **Images you mark are automatically added to a file collection.** Additionally, thumbnails of the images you've marked are shown in a separate panel in the viewer, and there are commands that make it easy to move around the marked images.
- If you want to take a break from your session you can simply close the viewer and come back to it later—all images that you've marked will be saved in the file collection. When you've marked one or more images and you close the viewer, Opus will automatically display the file collection for you in a new tab—you can change this behaviour in **Preferences**.

If the current image you're viewing is marked this is indicated with a star icon in the top-left corner

- To mark the current image in the viewer, simply push the M key (or click the Mark button on the toolbar).
- With the default configuration, a **file collection** will automatically be created based on the name of the image's parent folder.
- The marked image pane opens automatically on the left of the viewer window, showing thumbnails of the images you've marked. When this opens it automatically checks the collection for any images you may have already marked in a previous session.

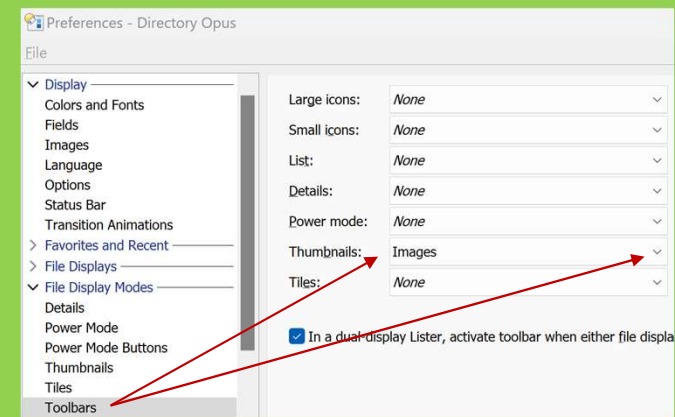


# How to Disable Images Toolbar in Thumbnail Mode

Some users find annoying the fact that the Image toolbar open up in Image mode (perhaps you just want to see the images, not edit them).

**Question:** How do I stop the images toolbar from opening automatically when I switch from details view to thumbnails view?

**Answer:** Go to **Preferences > File Display Modes > Toolbars** and turn off images in the Thumbnails field by clicking on *None* at the top of the drop-down menu.




# Scripts

- Directory Opus is supported by a large community of users who create and share buttons and scripts that you can use to be more efficient and enhance your Windows experience overall.
- The Directory Opus Resource Centre **Buttons/Scripts** section lists over hundreds of scripts, including some for Directory opus to interact with common programs such as **Everything, Dropbox, Calibre, Outlook**, “Attach to Mail (directly or as zip) for **Thunderbird**”, “Open **Google Maps** at Image's GPS Coordinates”.
- Scripts can easily be embedded in toolbar buttons.

**IMPORTANT**

Scripts are easy to install but **do follow the instructions given by their authors!**

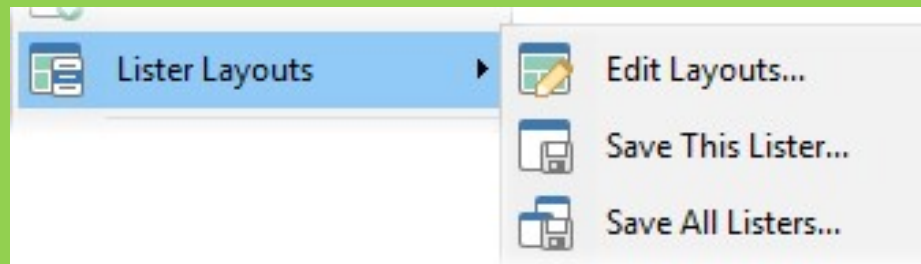

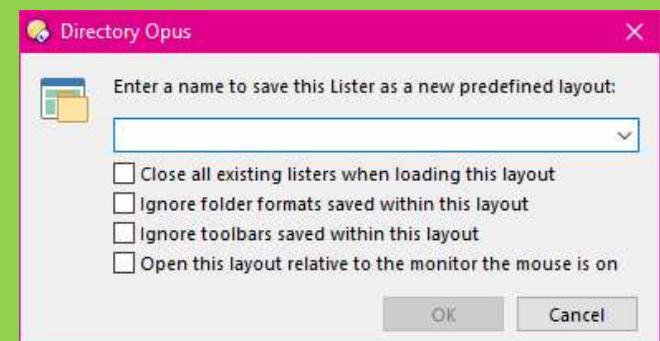


# How to Save Different Layouts for Different Purposes

- A **Lister Layout** is a saved collection of one or more Listers that you can re-open at any time. Layouts are created when you save your currently open Listers as a set using the commands in the Settings / Lister Layouts menu.



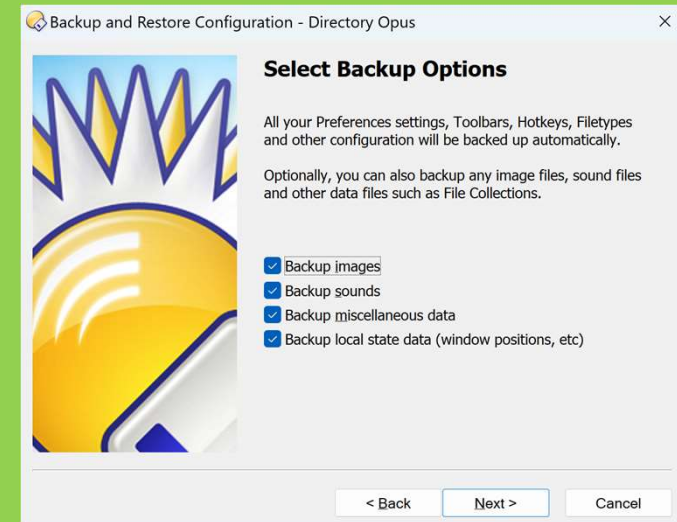
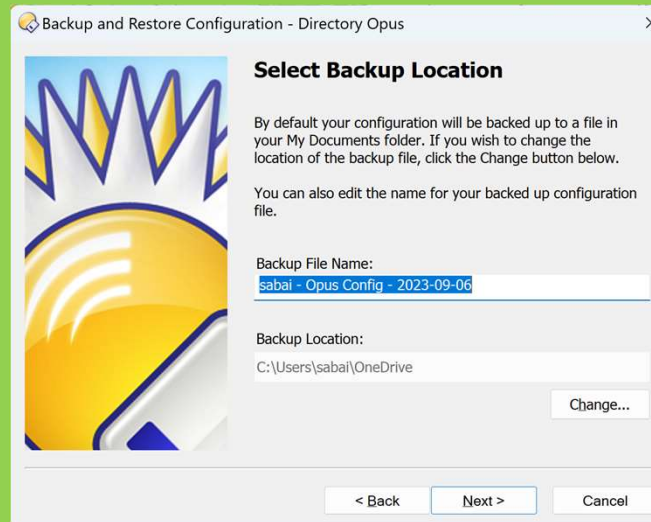
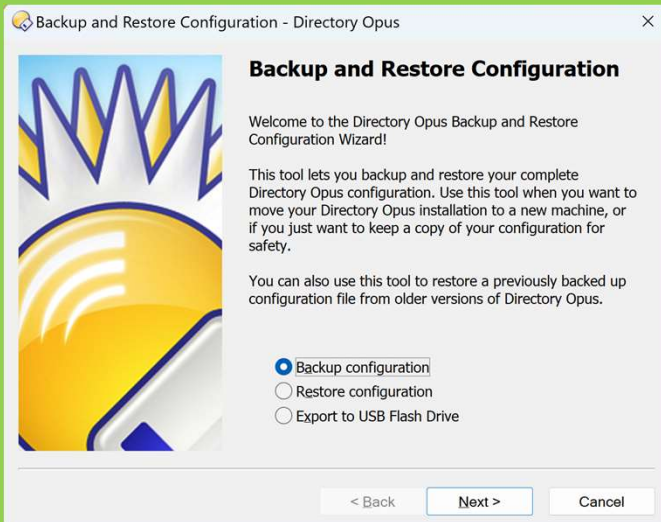
- The **Edit Layouts** command will open the **Preferences dialog** showing the **Layouts and Styles / Layouts** page. From this page you can view a list of all your saved layouts, rename them, re-order them, delete them, etc.
- The **Save This Lister** command saves only the currently active Lister, whereas the **Save All Listers** command saves **all** open Listers to the layout.

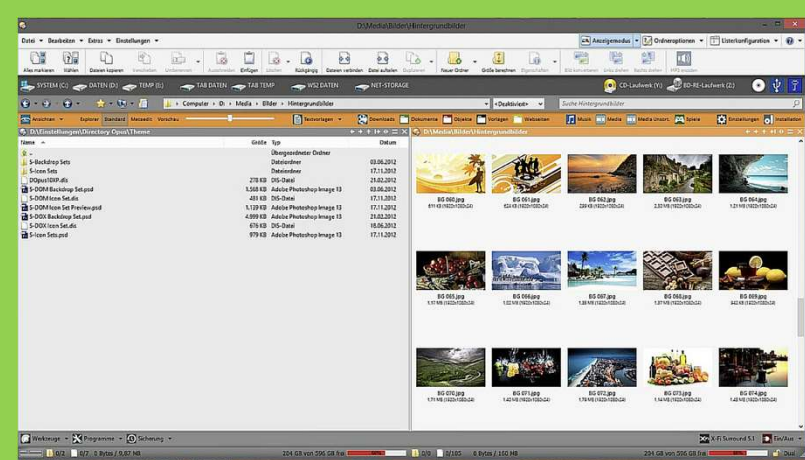
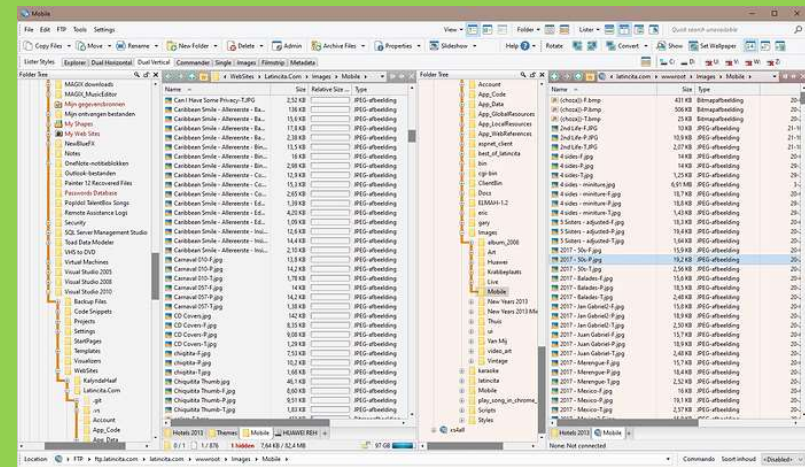
You can jump around the marked images by double-clicking their thumbnail. The marked image pane also lets you rename images by selecting their icon and pressing **F2**. The following keys relating to marking are also defined by default in the viewer:

- **M / Insert**: Mark / unmark the current image
- **Ctrl + M**: Show or hide the marked image pane
- **Ctrl + Left**: Jump to previously marked image
- **Ctrl + Right**: Jump to next marked image
- **Ctrl + Up**: Jump to first marked image
- **Ctrl + Down**: Jump to last marked image
- **Ctrl + Space**: Return from jump to last viewed image
- **Shift + M**: Exchange mark with previously marked image

These keys make it very easy to jump back and forth between images you've marked and your current "position" in the list of images.

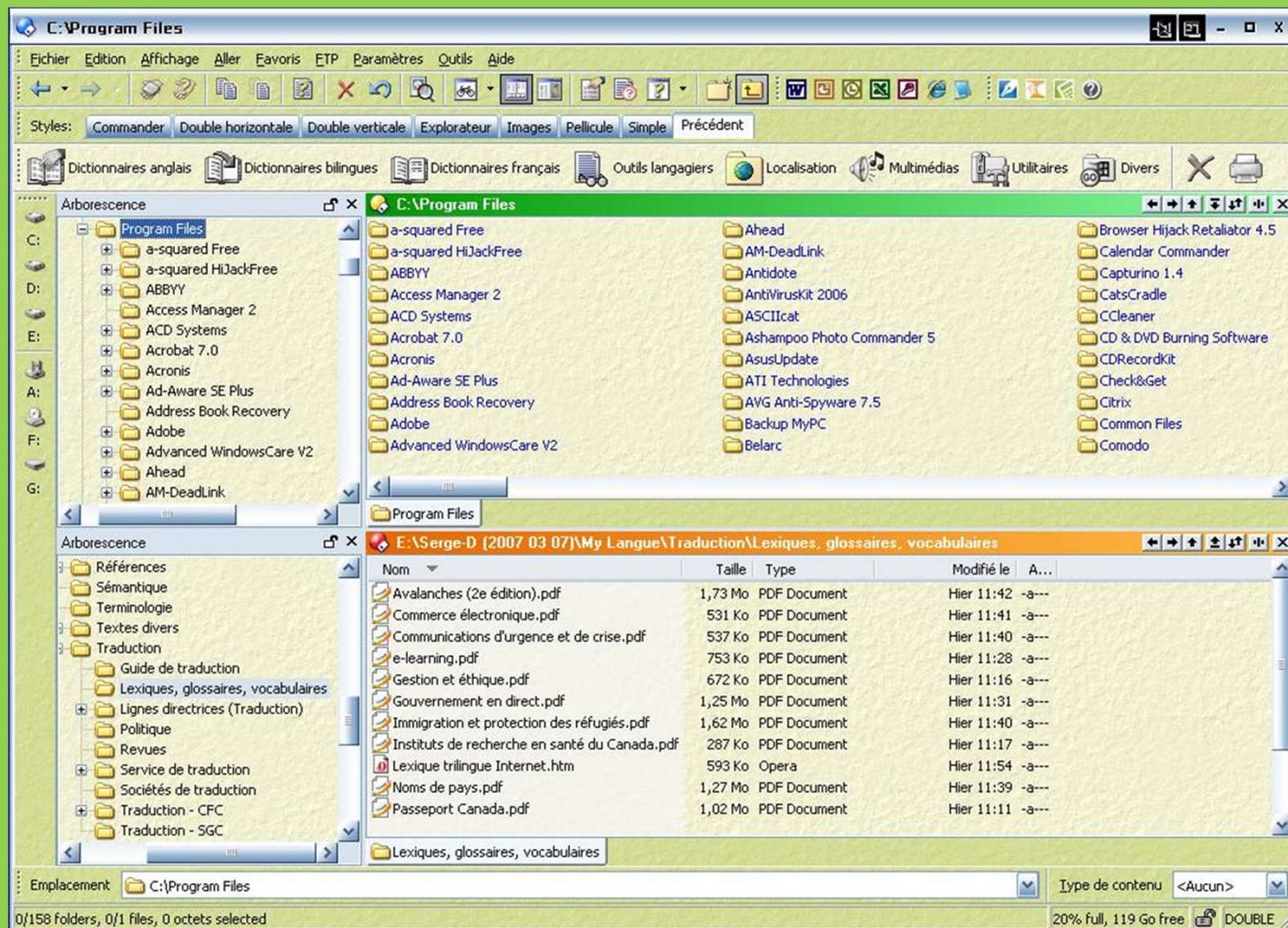
