- **Escape and Relaxation:** YouTube serves as an escape for some users who want to unwind and relax via nature scenes, or a diverse range of relaxation options.

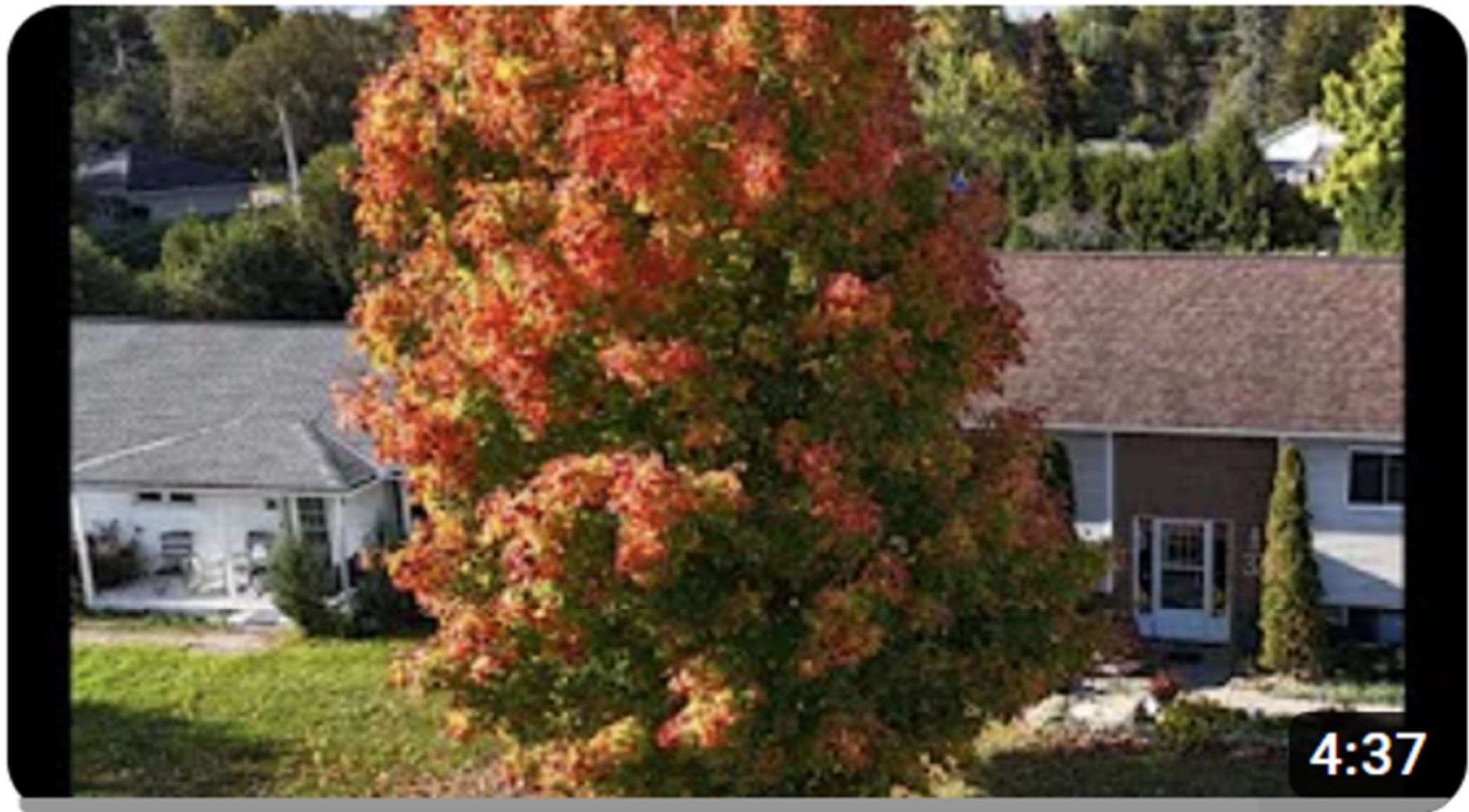
