## What is Remote Desktop

- Connect to another computer across a network
  - See the screen
  - Control keyboard and mouse
  - Optional extras
    - Transfer files
    - Text / video chat
    - Print



## Why use remote desktop

- Remote administration
  - Access a computer you are running but don't have physical access to
    - Typically no one at remote computer
- Remote assistance
  - Connect to someone else's computer to help them with a computer problem
    - Typically someone at remote computer

    - <http://www.radmin.com/>

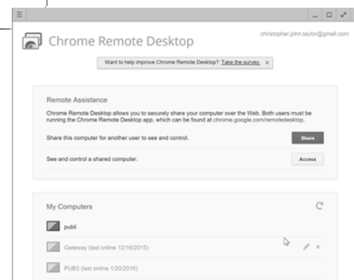


## Chrome Remote Desktop

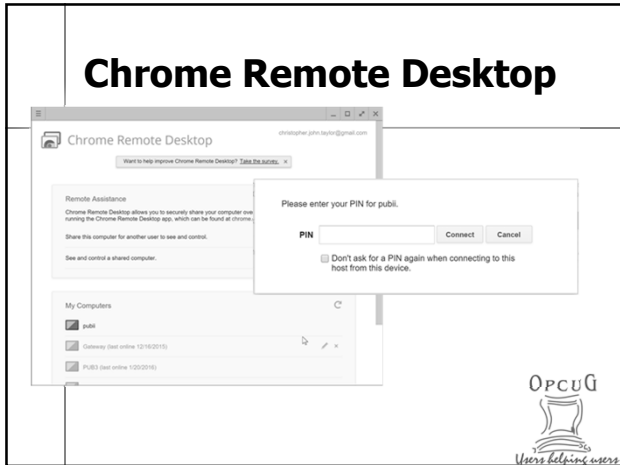
- Supports remote assistance and remote administration

- No file transfer capability

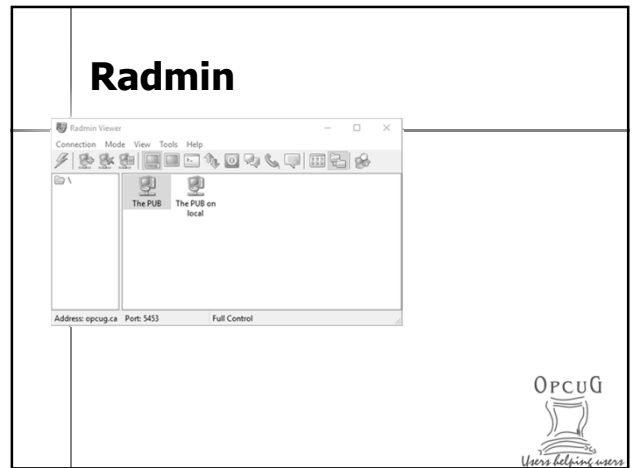


# Radmin

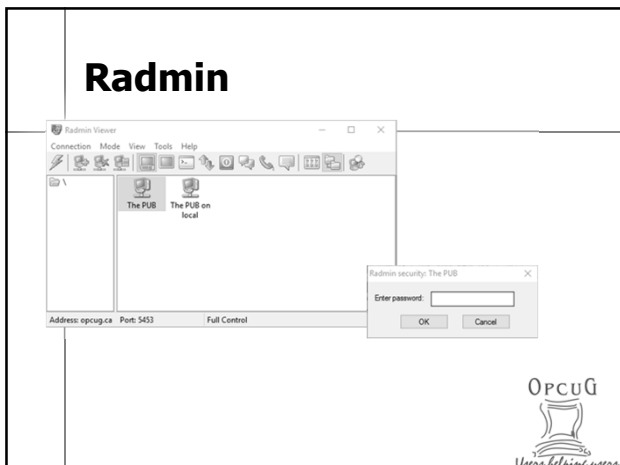
- Pay for "server" (US\$50)

- Will work even without vendor



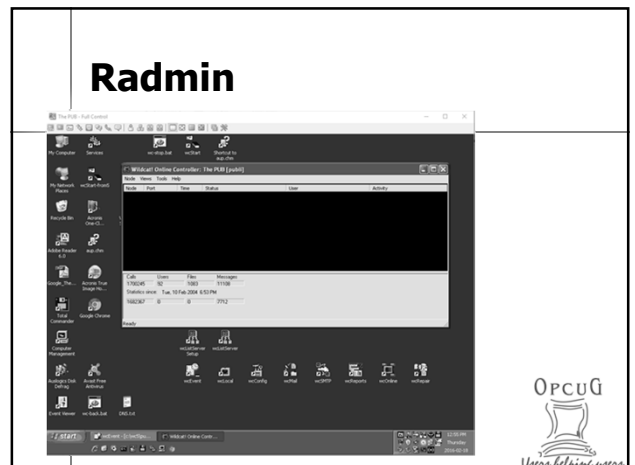

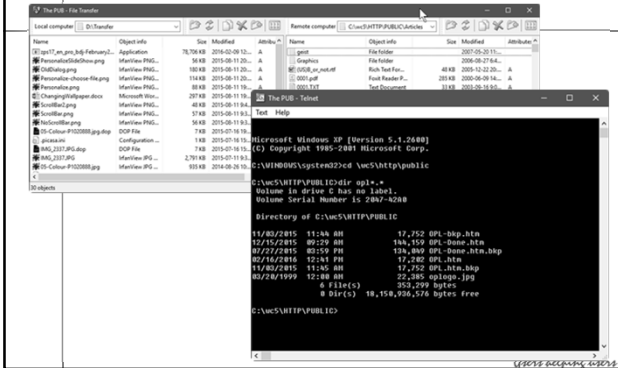

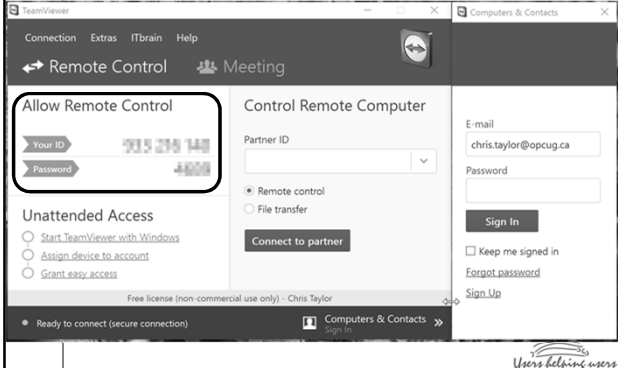


# TeamViewer

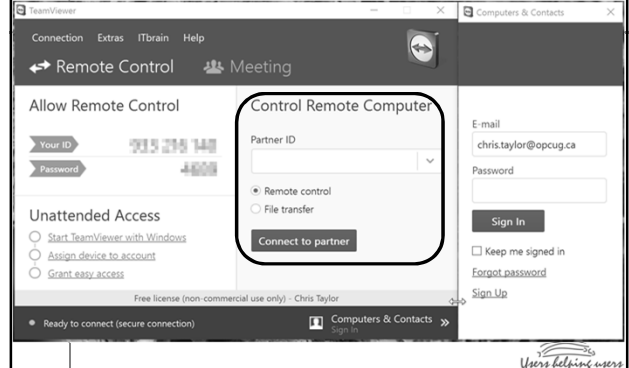
- Free for "private use"

  - File transfer, chat, video chat



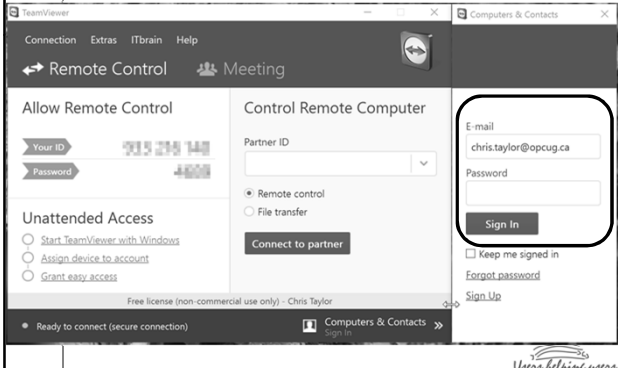

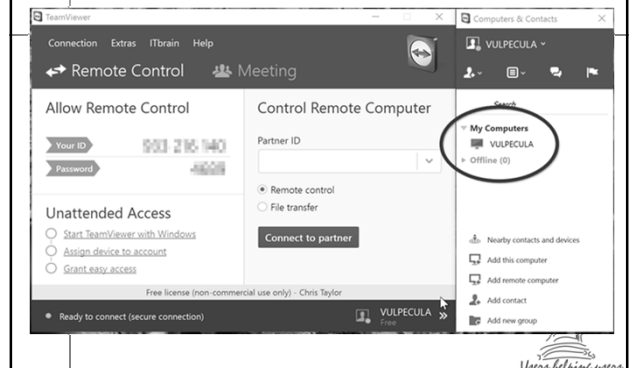

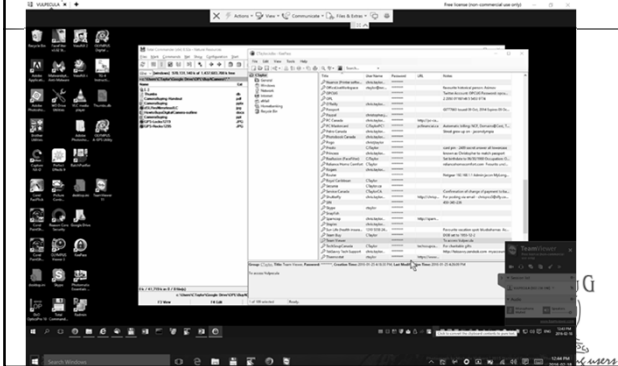
