



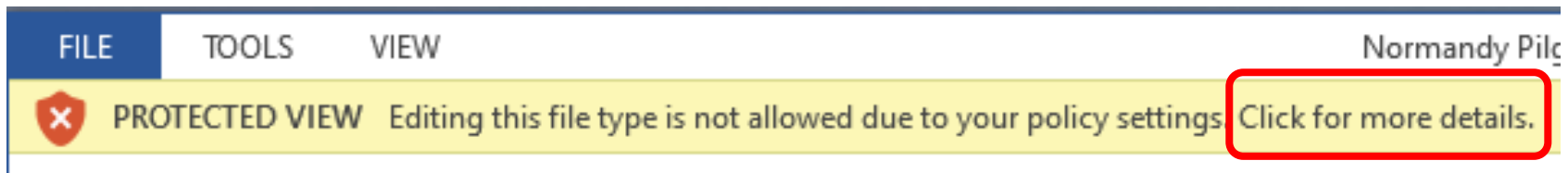

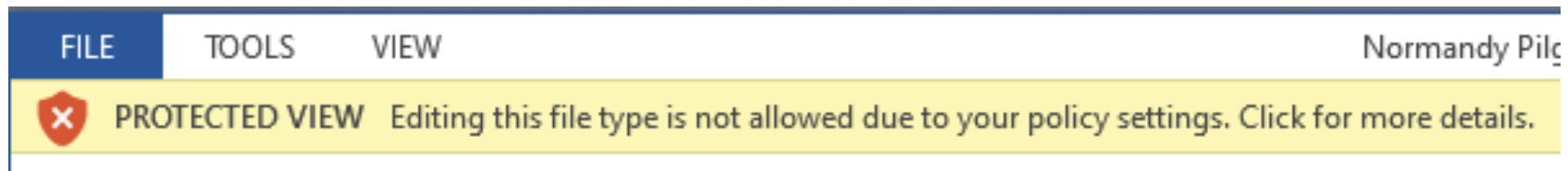

Protected View

Files from the Internet and from other potentially unsafe locations can contain viruses, worms, or other kinds of malware that can harm your computer. To help protect your computer, files from these potentially unsafe locations are opened as read only or in Protected View. By using Protected View, you can read a file and see its contents while reducing the risks. If you determine the file is safe, you can enable editing.

Important: We advise speaking with your administrator before you make changes to your Protected View settings

What do these settings mean?

- **Enable Protected View for files originating from the Internet** The Internet is considered an unsafe location because of its many opportunities for malicious intent.
- **Enable Protected View for files that are located in potentially unsafe locations** This refers to folders on your computer or network that are considered unsafe, such as the Temporary Internet folder or other folders assigned by your administrator.
- **Enable Protected View for Outlook attachments** Attachments in emails can come from unreliable or unknown sources. Sometimes malicious attachments can appear to come from trusted senders, or can come from compromised accounts of trusted senders. Always confirm with the other person if you receive an unexpected, or suspicious, attachment via email.



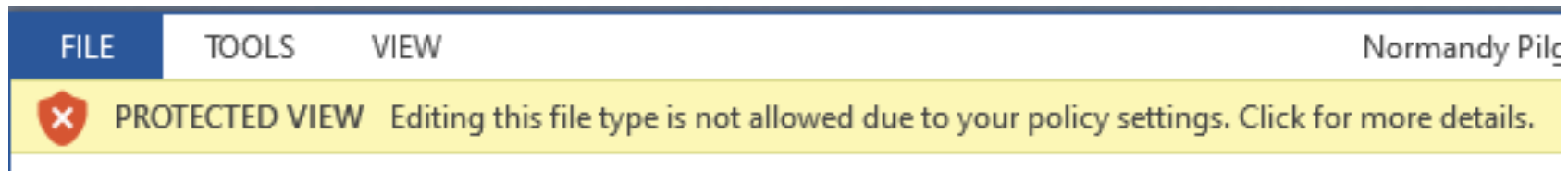

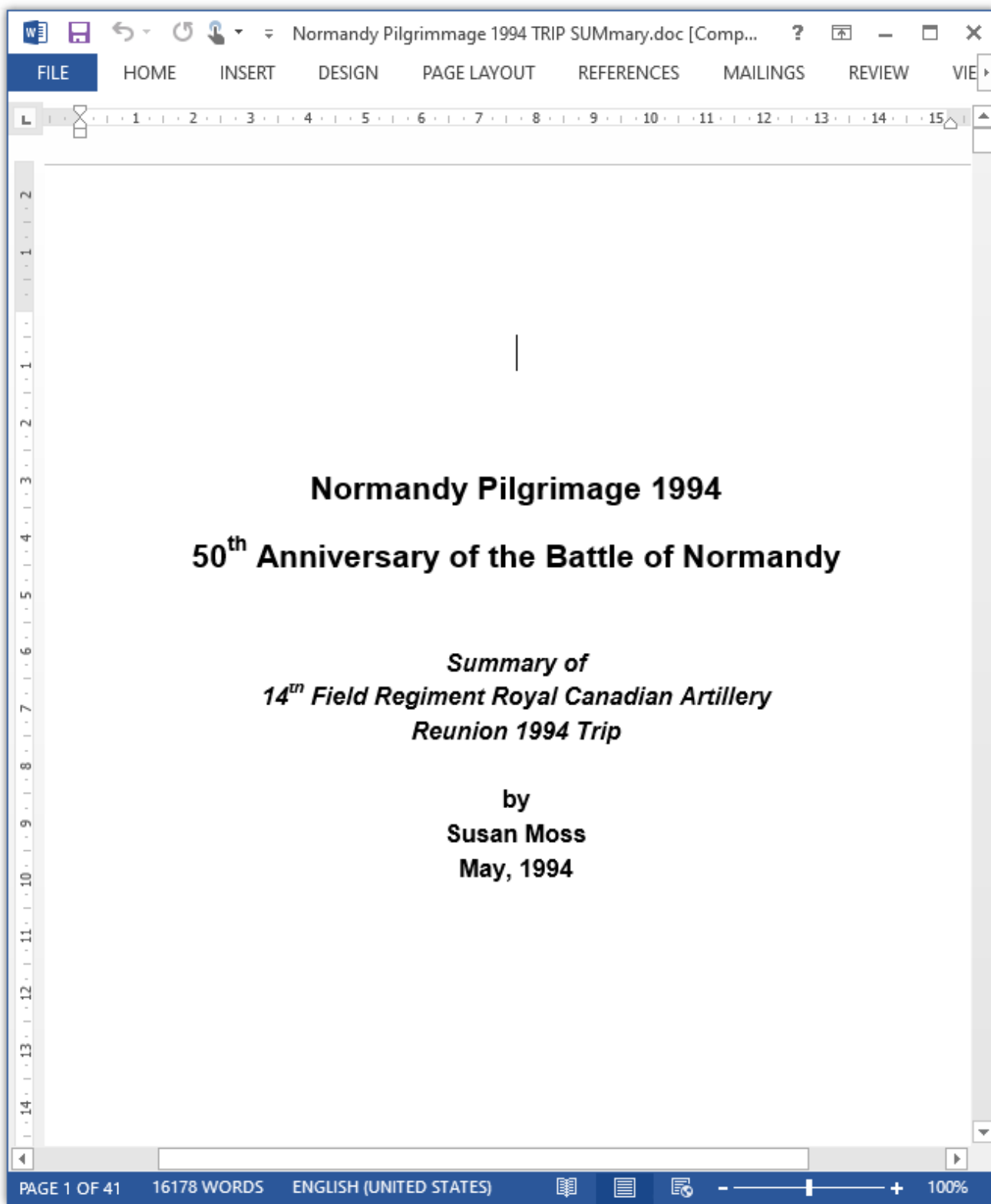

Monitors

- Many factors to consider
 - price
 - size
 - resolution
 - aspect ratio
 - specialty features
 - colour gamut



Search for monitors:

1,386 results

Resolution (number of pixels)

- 1366×768
 - common on small/budget laptops & small desktop monitors
- 1920×1080 (HD)
 - common on laptops & very common on desktop monitors
- 3840×2160 (4K)
 - higher-end laptops & pretty common on desktop monitors
- Specialty
 - 3440×1440
 - 3840×1080
 - 5120×1440
 - others

Resolution (number of pixels)

- Higher resolution (more pixels)
 - more fine detail
 - smaller items (may be overcome by *Windows scaling*)
 - higher power consumption
- Lower resolution (fewer pixels)
 - less fine detail
 - larger items (may be overcome by *Windows scaling*)
 - lower power consumption

Aspect ratio

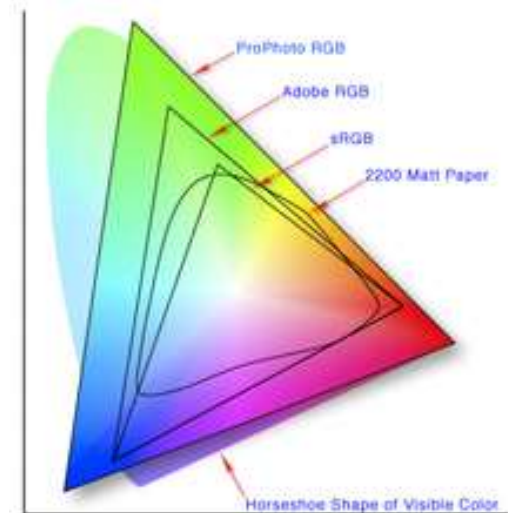
- 3:2 & 4:3 – some laptops
- 16:9 – HD & 4K
- 21:9 – ultrawide
- 32:9 – ultrawide
(super-ultrawide??)

Other considerations

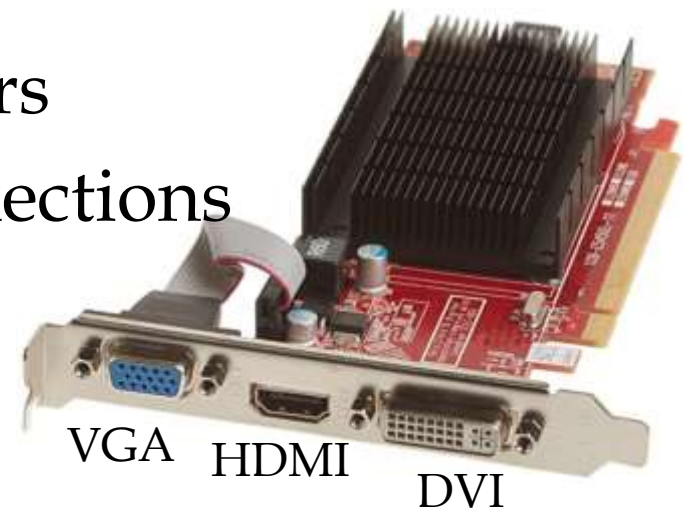
- Curved screen
 - some ultrawide monitors
 - distance from screen to eye more even
 - may have more problems with reflections
- Colour gamut (*colour space*)
 - ability to faithfully display a range of colours
 - most important for photographers
 - sRGB
 - Adobe RGB
 - ProPhoto RGB

Going beyond single monitor

- Get extra desktop real estate
 - more pixels!
 - bigger space!
 - display more application windows at once!
- Laptops usually have a port for an external monitor
- Desktops frequently have more than one monitor port
 - can often add another video card
- Extended desktop across all monitors
- May be different standards for connections
 - VGA, HDMI, DisplayPort, DVI
 - convert with dongles/cables

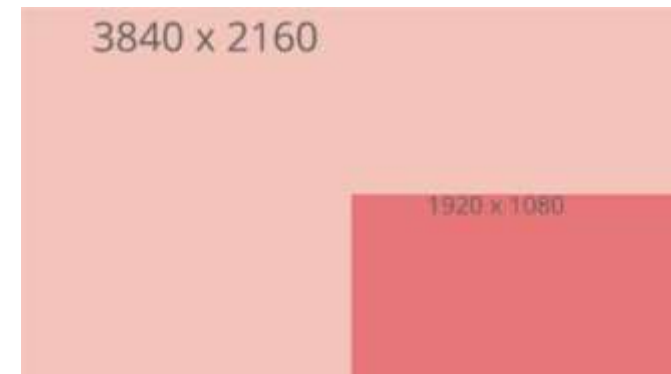
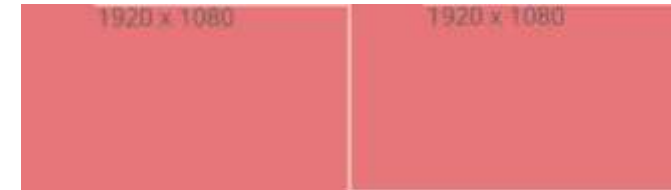

Chris's solution

- Old config:
 - dual Samsung 23" HD monitors
 - each: display area 20"×11", 1920×1080 resolution
 - together: display area 40"×11", 3840×1080 resolution
- New config:
 - single Philips 43" 4K monitor
 - display area 37"×21", 3840×2160
 - same size & resolution as four 23" monitors in one!

Chris's solution

- Benefits
 - no bezel between monitors
 - place app windows anywhere
 - work with single app full screen
 - lower cost than four 23" HD monitors
 - lower power consumption than four 23" HD monitors

Alan's "specialty feature"

- Second monitor - landscape rotates to portrait mode
- Edit Word file as full page (portrait)
- Select photos from image manager on laptop (landscape)

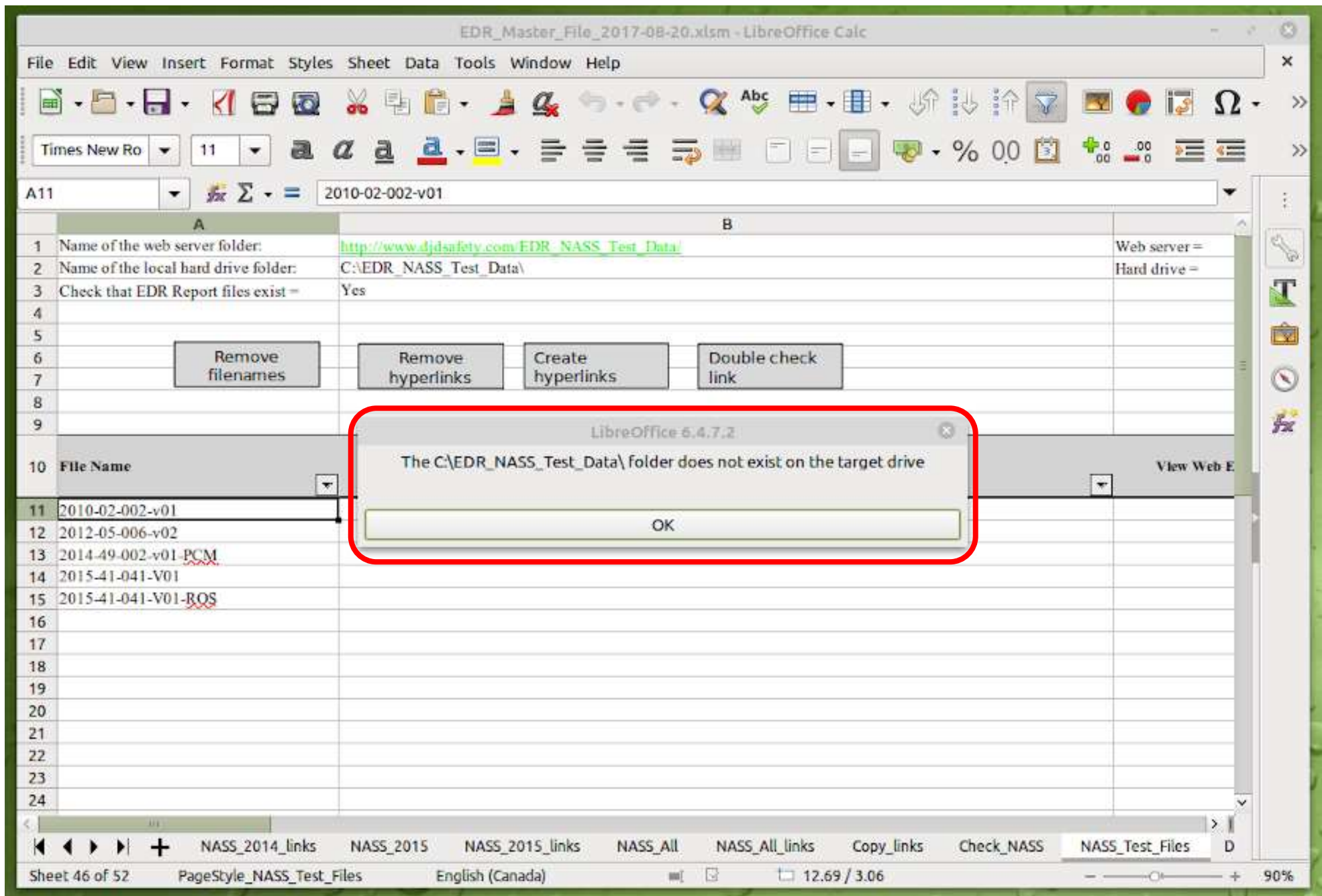

Working with VBA Macros

Visual Basic for Applications (VBA) is an implementation of Microsoft's Visual Basic which is built into all Microsoft Office applications.

Support for VBA is not complete, but it covers a large portion of the common usage patterns. Most macros use a manageable subset of objects in the Excel API (such as the Range, Worksheet, Workbook, etc.) and the support include those objects, and the most commonly used method/properties of those objects.

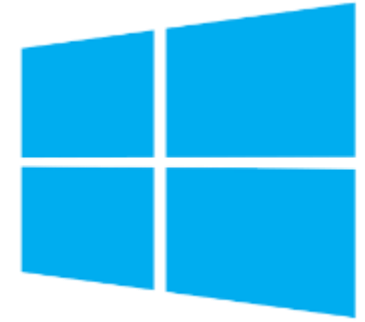
Loading Microsoft Office documents with executable VBA macros
