


Yet Another Update on Extended Security Updates (ESU)

- EOL for Windows 10 was nominally yesterday (October 14, 2025)
- Patch Tuesday was also yesterday
- There wouldn't have been any regular updates for another month (next Patch Tuesday)
- So, EOL is really in another four weeks!
- Have you enrolled for ESU yet?
- Have you been offered enrollment?
- There may be a reason for this...


- I almost always run Windows 10 with a regular user's account
- When I go to Windows Update, I see:




- Windows Update got stuck in a loop and one potential fix required logging in with an Administrator's account
- When I did this, I saw:



- When enrolling, my experience was the same as that for Chris:



- But, I hadn't backed up anything
- In fact, I declined offers to back up – **twice!** - before being offered enrollment !
- But, I did get enrolled in the ESU programme



- Huxe provides single audio daily news brief made specifically for you
 - sounds like two human hosts performing a podcast solely for your benefit


It gets even better!





DDoS Botnet Aisuru

- DDoS: distributed denial of service
 - when compromised devices are directed to flood a victim with data, preventing legitimate traffic
- Botnet:
 - collection of compromised devices under control of criminals
- Aisuru
 - most disruptive botnet to date
 - clocked at nearly **30 trillion bits of data per second**
 - estimated over **300,000 devices in botnet**
 - mostly U.S. based consumer-grade routers, security cameras, & digital video recorders operating with insecure/outdated firmware, and/or factory-default settings
 - some attacks directed at service providers with goal of forcing them to purchase a DDoS protection service that they controlled






- Developed by Christian Boxdörfer


Features




