# Comments in the Chat Window

- Last year I used Wealthsimple with Windows 10
- Ufile.ca cloud version is good
- I've been using StudioTax for years with Windows 10 and I'm happy with it. It costs \$15.
- Wealthsimple web
- I've been using TurboTax (desktop version) for many years. Apparently, it won't work on WIN 10, even with ESU. I don't want to use the online version. If I switch to another program, will the info that is usually transferred from 1 year to the next need to be put in manually, or is there any cross-compatibility? (I'm assuming not)

# Comments in the Chat Window

- Highly unlikely you can transfer info between different vendors. That would be cool!
- Just saw this on the TurboTax site: "Though we recommend using Windows 11, the Canadian version of TurboTax Desktop 2025 will run on Windows 10. Please see this TurboTax Canada FAQ for more information: How does the end of support for Windows 10 affect my TurboTax Desktop experience?"
- That must be new, I looked at this a few days and it said Win11 only.

# Comments in the Chat Window

- That was from an Admin reply in Aug. HOWEVER, when I went to the download page, the system requirements list WIN 11 and not previous versions. I'm now confused! Will get in touch with them and see what they say.\*
- Google CRA SimpleFile. CRA can calculate for simple returns

*\* TurboTax has changed things so it should work on Windows 10. This is not reflected in the requirements stated on the website's download page.*

*Ignore any warnings when installing the software.*

*If the download does not work, a refund can be issued.*



## SimpleFile doesn't work for me!

- Part of the criteria to be allowed to use the free service is a mix of age, province and income.
- For me, being in Ontario and over 65 years old - an income of greater than \$18,970 made me ineligible.
- \$18,970!!!!
- If I was under 65 years old, the threshold is \$12,747!
- I suspect Perplexity.AI's estimation that 2 million Canadians would be eligible is wildly overestimated!

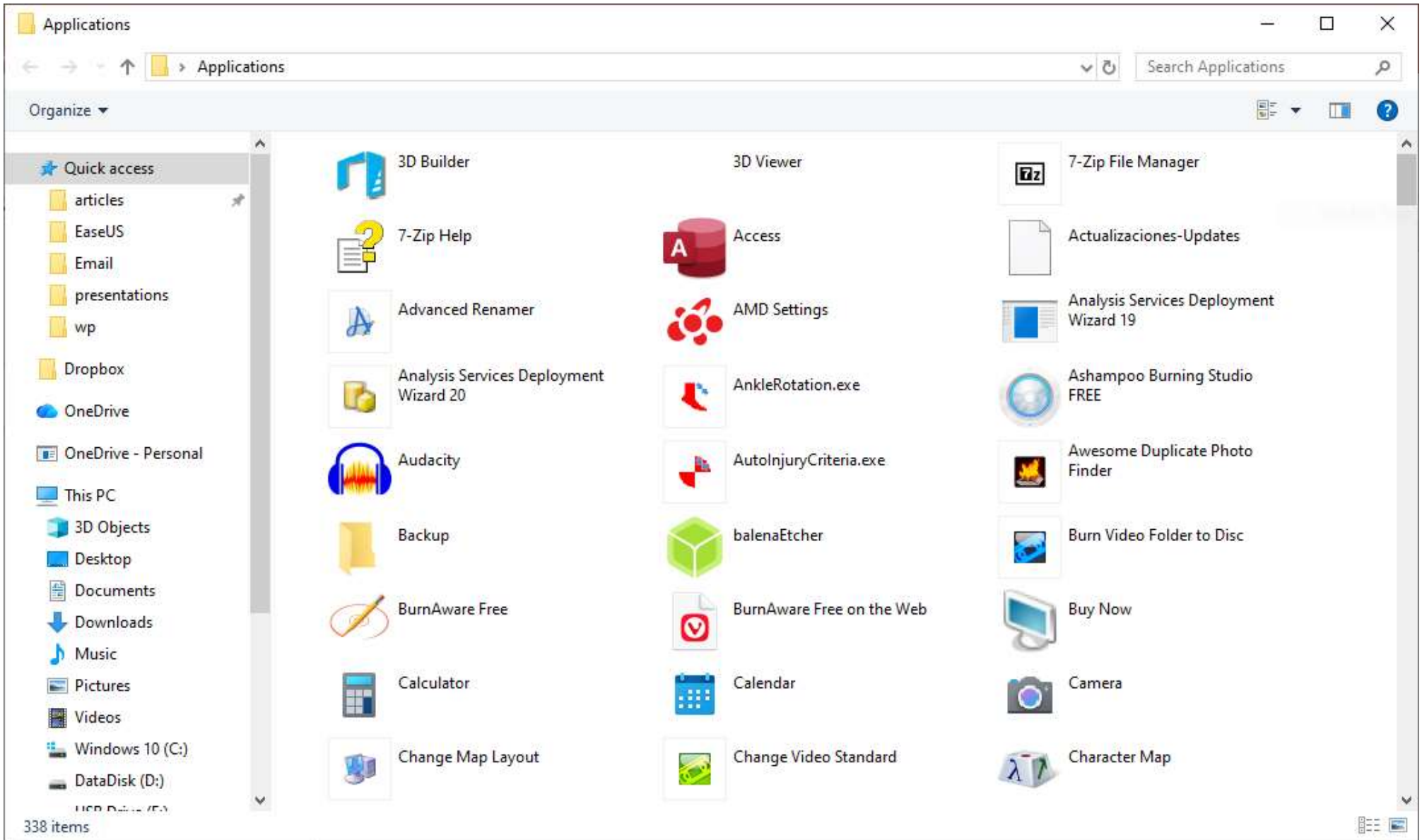

# shell:appsfolder

- A special Windows command that opens a hidden system folder listing all installed applications on your computer
- Press Windows + R, type *shell:appsfolder*, press Enter
- Folder view shows both traditional desktop programs and modern Microsoft Store apps in one place
- Not a physical folder on your drive; a virtual system location
- Use to
  - see all installed apps in one location
  - right-click apps to create desktop shortcuts
  - uninstall certain programs
  - drag apps into folders or onto the desktop

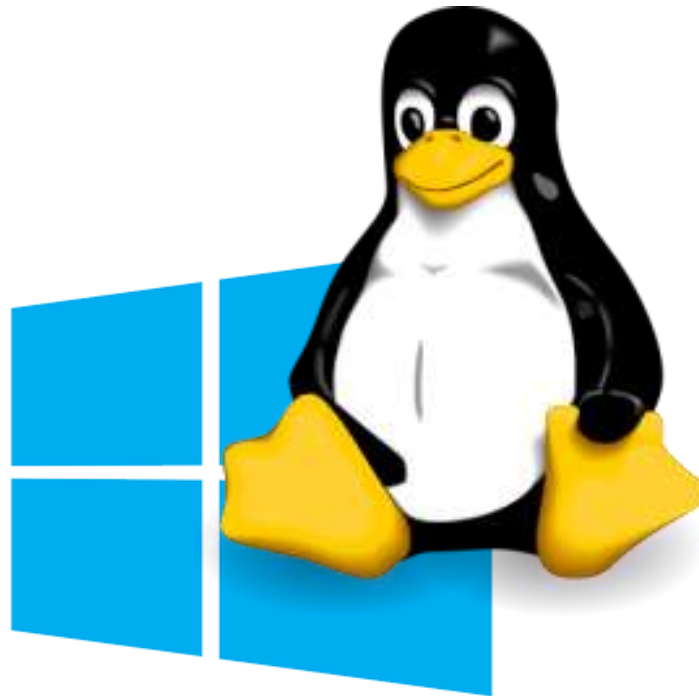

# Linux Terminology

- **Linux**
  - the Linux kernel
  - manages all the system tasks such as:
    - timing and scheduling of CPU operations
    - handling I/O for peripheral devices
    - enforcing security protocols
- **Linux Distribution (distro)**
  - add utilities and applications
    - file manager, text editor, office suite, web browser, E-mail client, and a media player.

# Linux Distros

- Distrowatch.com lists more than 1000 distros
- Includes active, dormant and discontinued versions
- Also includes some Berkeley Software Distribution (BSD) variants
- Even so, **there are 399 active distros!**



# Why so many?

- Open source; anyone can release their own distro
- Multiple developers - corporate, community, individual
- Distros for:
  - beginners and advanced users
  - Single PC and network servers
- Different philosophies:
  - long-term stability and cutting-edge
  - file system, software repositories, etc.

# Good or Bad?

**That depends...**

- Windows-only users may find the number of choices to be overwhelming
- Experienced Linux users appreciate the level of control and degree of customization that are available

# Main Distros

- Debian
  - stable release, long-term support
  - Ubuntu, Linux Mint variants
- Arch Linux
  - rolling release, cutting edge
  - Manjaro, EndeavourOS and CachyOS
- Red Hat Software
  - Red Hat Enterprise Linux (RHEL)
  - The Fedora Project, Rocky Linux, Alma Linux

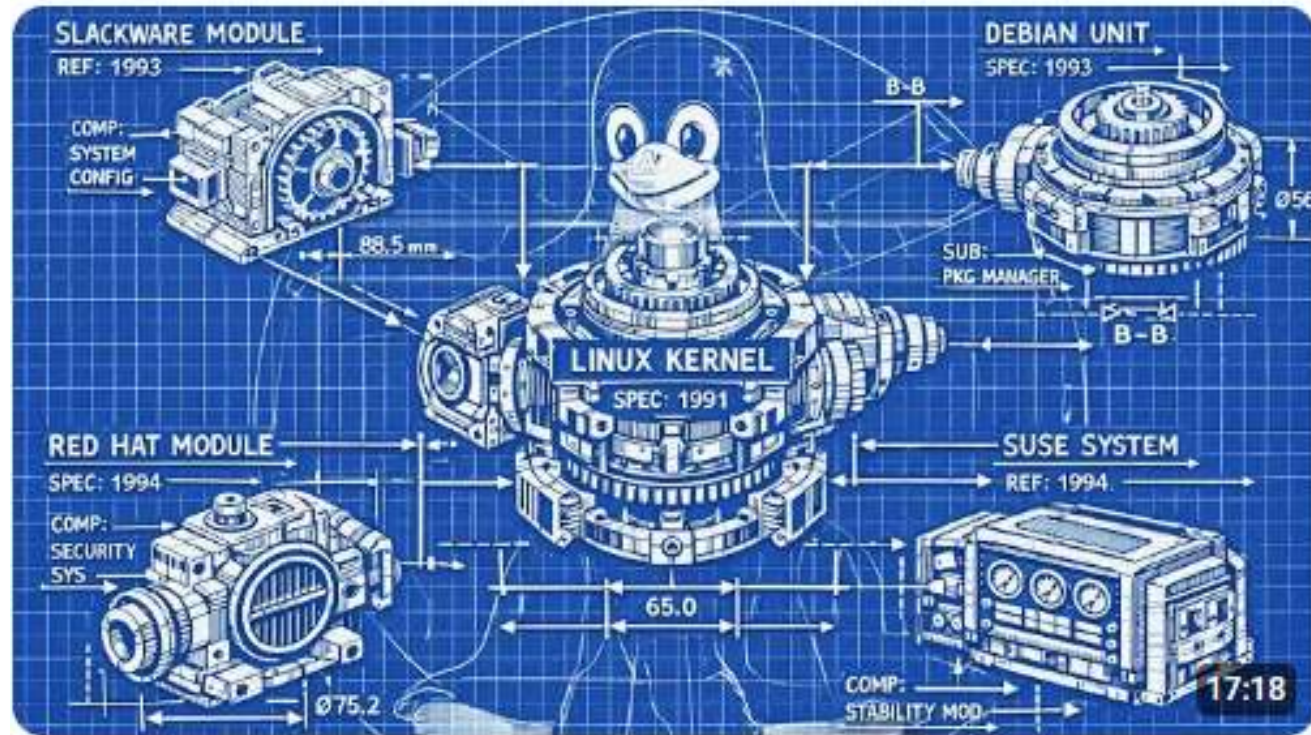
# Other Notable Distros

- Slackware
  - oldest surviving Linux distribution
- Gentoo
  - most software and the Linux kernel normally built from source
- SUSE/openSUSE
  - enterprise and community versions
- Many other distros
  - lightweight design, advanced features, alternative package management systems e.g. Alpine Linux

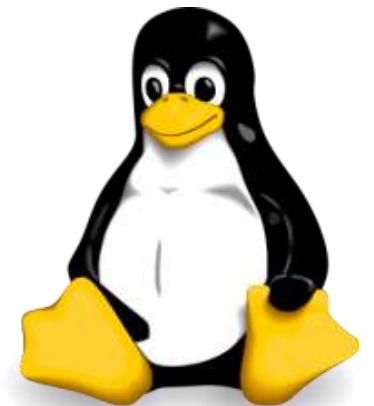

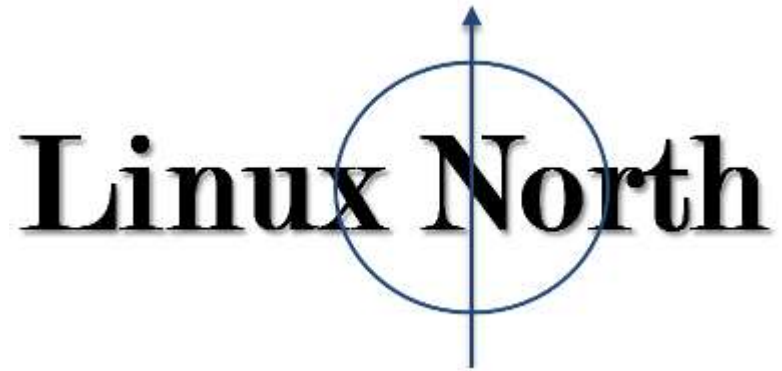

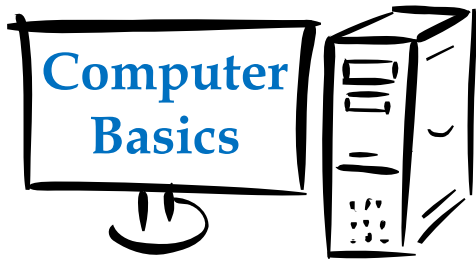

# Keyboard shortcuts #3



- Today's shortcut: Delete by word

## Most commonly used

Delete

deletes *letter to right* of insertion cursor, *letter by letter*

Backspace

deletes *letter to left* of insertion cursor, *letter by letter*

Ctrl

Delete

deletes *word to right* of insertion cursor, *word by word*

# QuickInstaller

- Users may submit applications for inclusion in the database
- Login to the QuickInstaller site
- Submit details of the new program
- Vote on the submission
- The new application needs to be verified and tested by QuickInstaller's developer before it is available
- This may take some time due to the number of submissions and there being a single developer





## Hotmail messages stored to laptop (without permission)

- Using Proton Mail when a message sent to a Microsoft Exchange server timed out and bounced
- When I clicked on it, all my Hotmail messages appeared!
- Then I ran Outlook icon to see what would happen
- I was not prompted for my password and all my messages appeared
- Perplexity AI suggests that this may be automatic synchronization behavior in Windows 11
- Google suggests Windows updates caused previously-downloaded Outlook messages to be re-downloaded
- Has anyone else seen/fixed this issue?



# Accessing PST Files

- I have many Outlook Classic .pst files that I like to search to read/print selected emails
- I no longer have the Outlook Classic program
- I've used with limited success the GoldFynch Chrome extension that Chris presented at Q&A on 2024-07-03
- More recently I watched this video:

- I'd like to do this but it requires having Outlook Classic
- Do you know of a workaround?
