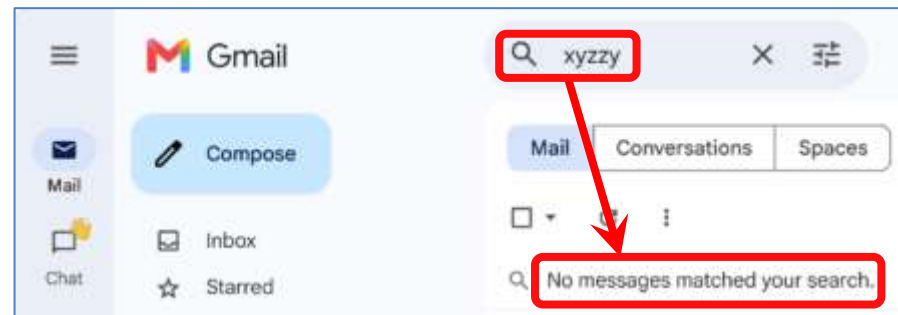
Finding lost Gmail emails



Share

Where the heck is that email?

- An email in Gmail (mysteriously) disappears
 - or never shows up in the first place!
- You need to find the email
- You use the search box
- The email is not found
- Assumption: you have not emptied the trash
 - which would permanently remove the item
 - making it unrecoverable
- The email *must* still be there somewhere

- doesn't look in **spam** and **trash**
- if an email is missing you want to look **everywhere!**

Gmail internal organization

- For the most part, Gmail treats your entire mailbox as a single bucket
- Gmail uses **labels** to create illusion of **folders**
- An email can have multiple labels
 - allows a single email to appear in multiple locations, e.g. **Inbox, Promotions, Archives, Vacations, Hobbies**, etc.

Important nuances about labels

- If you **copy** an email from **Inbox** to **Vacations**
 - Gmail doesn't have a **copy** button: choose **Labels**
 - Gmail adds the label **Vacations** & keeps label **Inbox**
 - the email appears whether viewing **Vacations** or **Inbox**

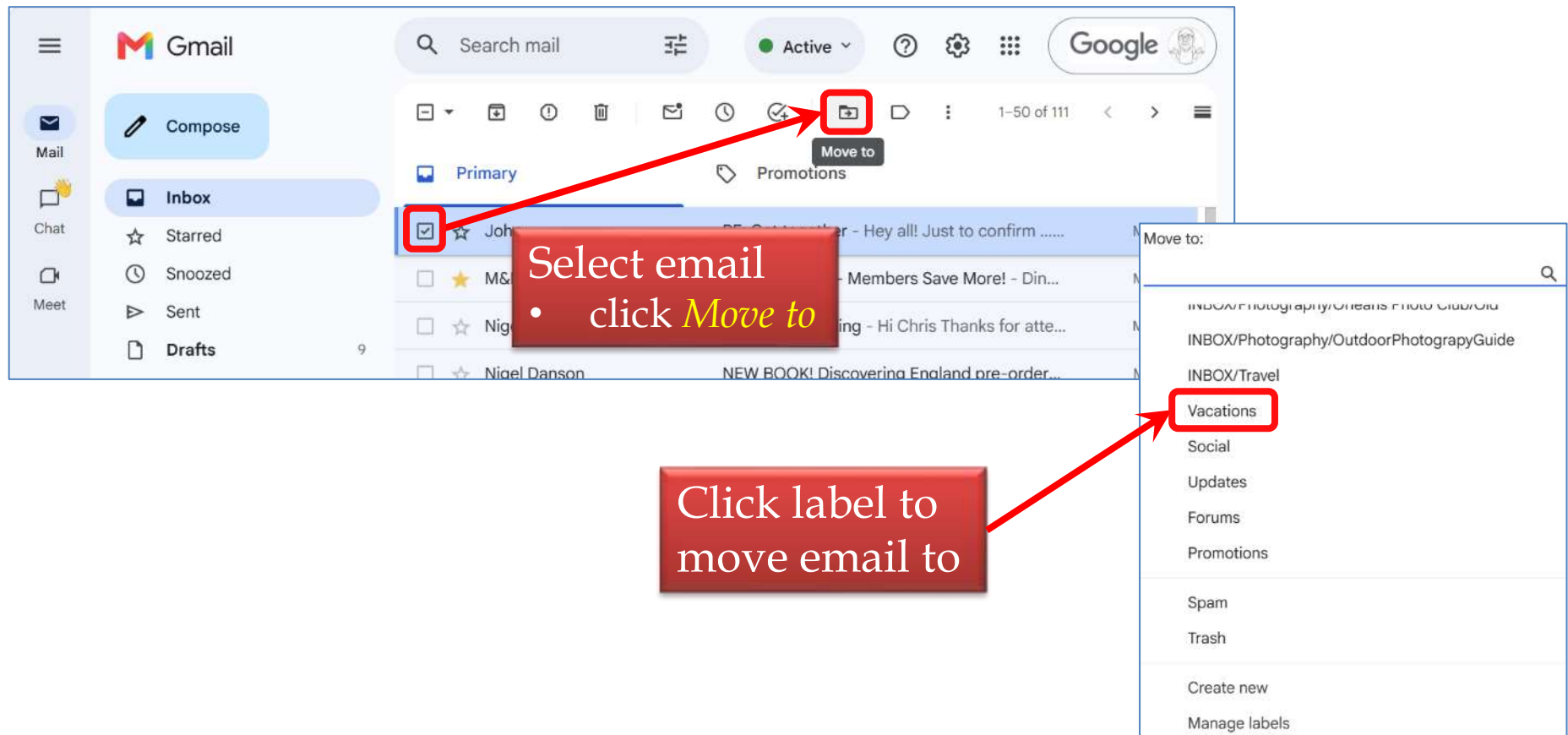

Important nuances about labels

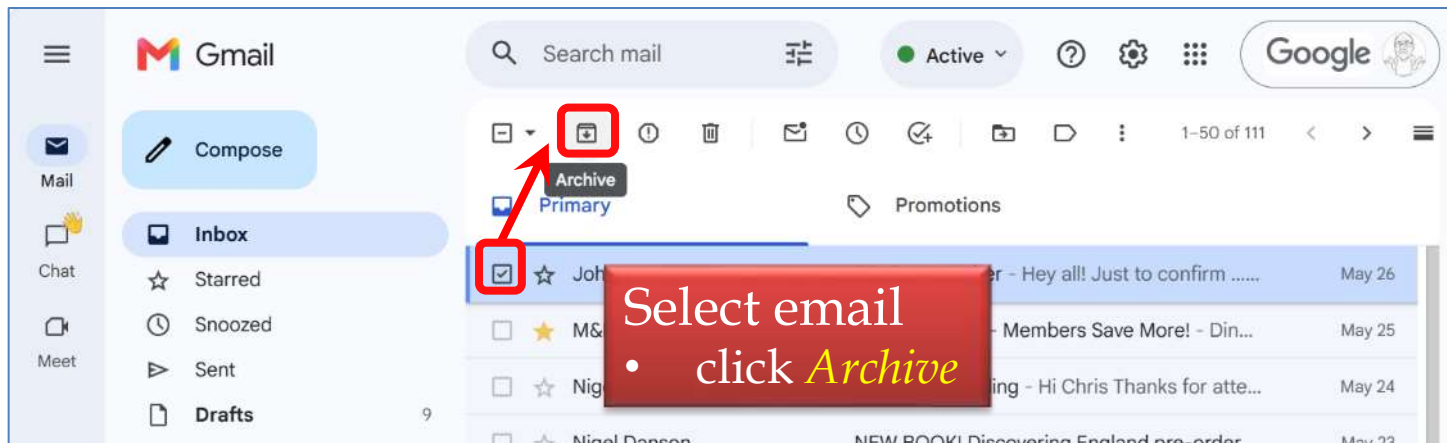
- If you **move** an email from **Inbox** to **Vacations**
 - Gmail adds label **Vacations** & **removes** the **Inbox** label
 - the email no longer appears when viewing **Inbox**

Important nuances about labels

- If you archive an email
 - Gmail removes the **Inbox** label
 - email isn't visible when viewing your **Inbox**

Special areas

- Gmail defines two special system areas
 - **Spam** and **Trash**
- Allows Google to apply retention rules
 - e.g. automatically delete items after 30 days
- **These areas are normally ignored when searching**
 - use built-in views to search **Trash** and **Spam**
 - search using **In:Trash** or **In:Spam**
 - *In:Trash Florida* – emails in trash with the word Florida
 - *In:Spam Ottawa* – emails classified as spam with the word Ottawa

To find all emails

- Use search prefix **In:anywhere**, e.g.
 - *In:Anywhere xyzzy* – find any email with the word *xyzzy*
- Can combine with other search operators, e.g.
 - In:Anywhere xyzzy from:joe.user@rogers.com
 - In:Anywhere xyzzy after:2026-05-01
 - In:Anywhere subject:"Colossal Cave" newer_than:2d
 - In:Anywhere xyzzy has:attachment

Wayward messages

- Once you find a wayward message
 - make sure you can find it more easily in the future

Right-click

- *Move to inbox*

Right-click

- *Move to a label*

If labelled as spam, right-click

- *Not spam*
- will be moved to Inbox

Progress to date/Future changes

- Select the folders to be compared
- Double-click to change directories
- Copy files between the folders

But need to...

- Synchronize the scroll bars so that files which are the same in both folders are aligned
- Introduce a central column to indicate the status of two files (same/newer)
- Allow sorting of the file listings by name, size, and date-time stamp

Please add a central column between the two panes that will indicate the status of each file pair. If the left and right files have the same date-time stamp place a blue check mark in the central column. Otherwise display an arrow pointing towards the file that has the newest date-time stamp.

To add a **central status column** like the original PC Magazine WMatch, we need to change the layout slightly.

Instead of two independent tables, we create **three aligned tables**:

LEFT PANE | STATUS | RIGHT PANE

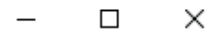


The **status column** will show:

✓ **blue check mark** → timestamps identical

← **arrow left** → left file

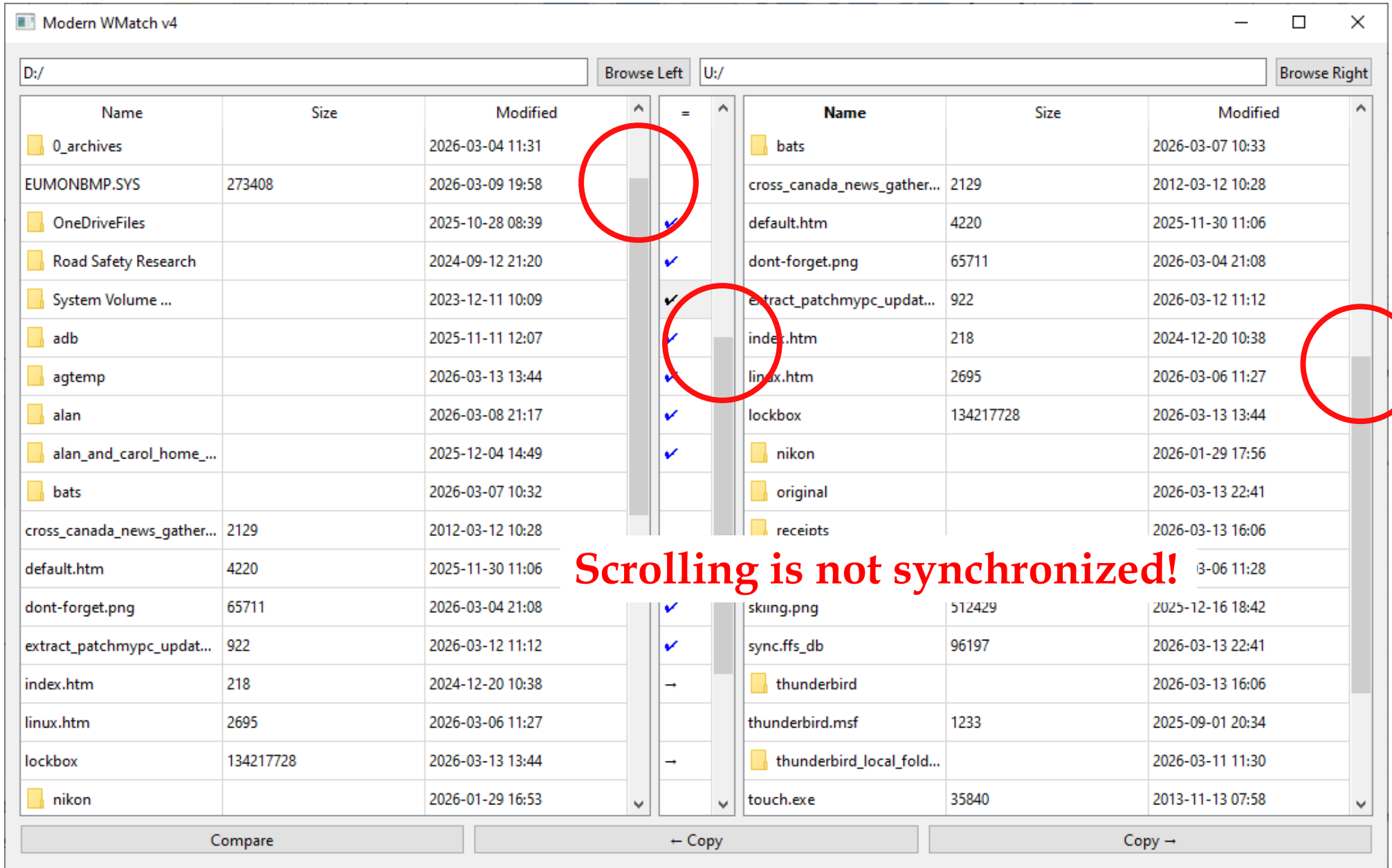

Consolidate the scroll bars for the three tables into a single scroll bar on the right and maintain synchronization for the files in both the left and right tables. Change the left arrow used in the central table to << and the right arrow to >> and centre the icons in the central table

Below is a **clean rebuilt version of `wmatch_commander_style_v5.py` updated to v5.1** with the exact changes you requested:

Changes from v5

1. **Single shared scrollbar** on the far right controlling all three panes
2. **Left and right tables remain perfectly synchronized**
3. **Central status column uses << and >>** instead of arrows
4. **Status symbols centered** in the central column
5. **No individual table scrollbars** (hidden)
6. **Status column width tightened** for a classic WMatch look

This approach mimics how classic tools like [PC Magazine WMatch](#) kept rows visually aligned.

This hides the right scroll bar as well as the left and centre scroll bars

You're correct — the previous version unintentionally **hid the internal scrollbars and therefore prevented the tables from scrolling at all**. The external scrollbar was changing their values, but because Qt had effectively disabled the internal scrollbars, the tables could not move.

The master scroll bar isn't displayed once the folders to be compared are selected

Good catch — the problem comes from how the **master scrollbar range is initialized**.

In the previous script the master scrollbar range is copied from the left table **before Qt has recalculated the table layout**, so the scrollbar maximum becomes **0**, which causes Qt **not to display the scrollbar**.

- Samsung states that by setting Google Messages as the default SMS app, all of the messages will be migrated within 24 hours
- As it's always good to be cautious, is there a way to back up everything in Samsung Messages before switching to another app?

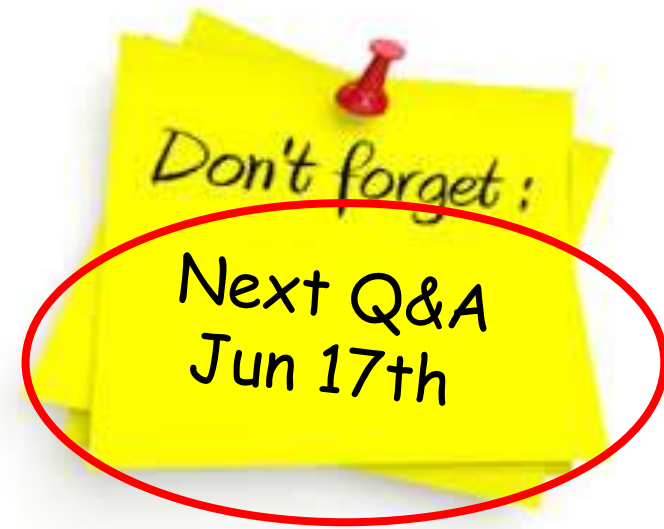
