Red Flags - Why is this a scam?

-  E-mail domain (**getresponse-mail**) is not that of Tim Hortons
-  Incorrect spelling of company name: **Tim Horton** (should be **Tim Hortons**)
-  Use of bait (“Win \$200” and “We have a surprise”)
-  -Domain name in URL is **owl.li** (should be <https://www.timhortons.com/>)
-Unsubscribe link is an IP address (**89.144.62.29**)
(beware of IP addresses – they give no clue as to their destination)
