Red Flags - Why is this a scam?



The return E-mail address (@fastservice.com) has nothing to do with Rogers Cable Communications Inc. A Google search shows that fastservice.com is a free E-mail provider.



The use of English (e.g. "*You email have reached...*") is extremely poor.



Hovering the mouse over "UPGRADE NOW" shows that the link is pointing to a weebly.com website and not to Rogers.
