

Video-conferences for general meetings as well as Q&A

The Zoom video-conference opens at 7:20pm. The meeting begins at 7:30pm.

If you have not used Zoom, it is recommended that you browse to <https://zoom.us/test> where you can install the client software and test your hardware.

1. To connect to the meeting using the Zoom client:

After 7:20pm on the meeting date, browse (Google Chrome recommended) to <https://tinyurl.com/opcug-meeting>. You will be prompted to download and install the client software or to launch it if it is already installed. Follow the prompts. The Meeting ID is **924 9556 0898**.

If you prefer not to use the client software, you can join using a web browser. Click “join from your browser” that appears on the web page in the paragraph above. Note that some features are not available when using a browser, such as gallery view, the ability to participate in polls, use of virtual backgrounds, and more.
