Typography—the art and science of arranging type—has been around for over 500 years and is constantly evolving. Good typography makes it easy to read and can be eye-catching. Bad typography can be distracting and hard to read.

Chris will outline the somewhat arcane terminology used. He will discuss some of the historical significances of type. Then Chris will delve into the subjective nature of choosing typefaces: what makes a typeface more or less readable, how and when to combine multiple typefaces, what emotions are evoked in readers, and how to avoid common faux pas.
